Review this week's message.

**Key Scripture:** [2 Timothy 3:14-17](#), [Psalm 119:105](#), [Hebrews 4:12](#)

**Start talking. Get the conversation rolling.**

- Would you rather have to get all your news from a 60-year-old who still gets a newspaper delivered, or a 14-year-old who only uses TikTok? No other options.

**Start sharing. Be open with your group.**

- What stood out to you the most from this week's message?
- When you've got a big decision to make — money, relationships, a major life call — where do you actually go first for answers? Be honest.
- Pastor Josh mentioned we're spending over two hours a day on social media, getting hit with hot takes and no accountability. What do you think that's quietly doing to the way we think?
- Read [2 Timothy 3:16](#). In your own words — what do you think it means for something to actually be *useful* in the way that verse describes?
- One of the most common pushbacks people have is: "The Bible has survived this long, but the world has changed too much." How would you respond to someone who said that to you?
- A lot of people keep the Bible at arm's length — they respect it, but they don't actually let it into their decisions, their habits, their real life. What do you think keeps most people from crossing that line?

**Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.**

- Ask God to do what no algorithm can — cut through the noise and speak something specific to you. Give Him permission to make His Word more than words on a page.

**Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.**

- Pick one decision, habit, or question you've been letting the internet answer for you — and this week, open your Bible and actually look for what God says about it instead.
