

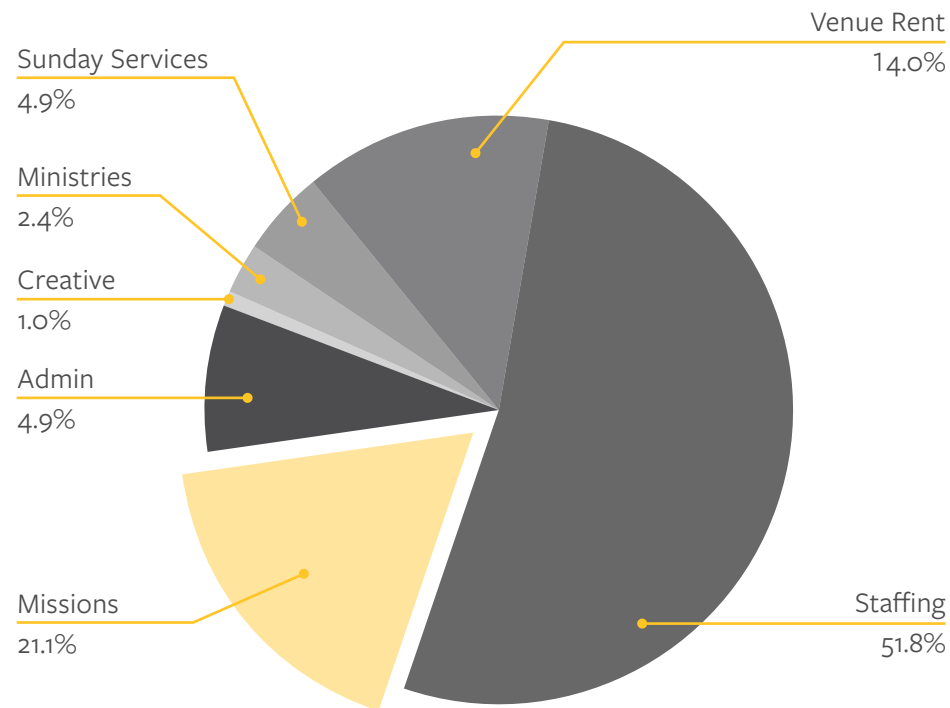

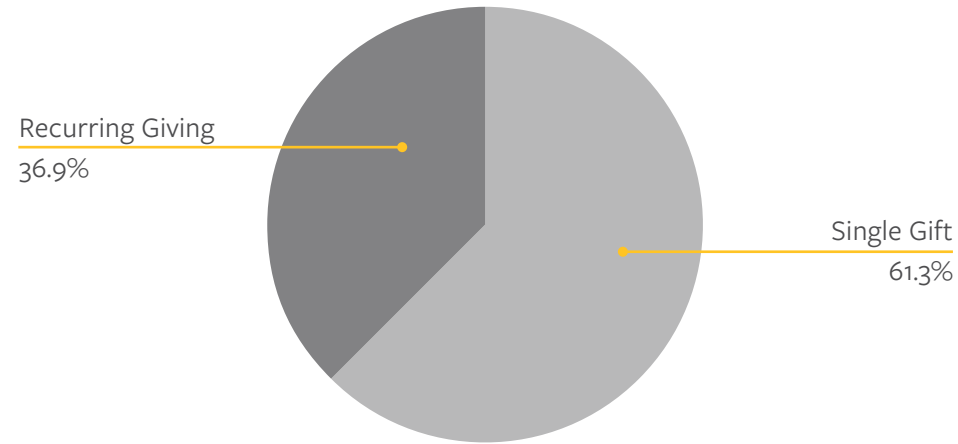


### TOTAL SOWN INTO MISSIONS \$3,180,000+ over the last 5 years

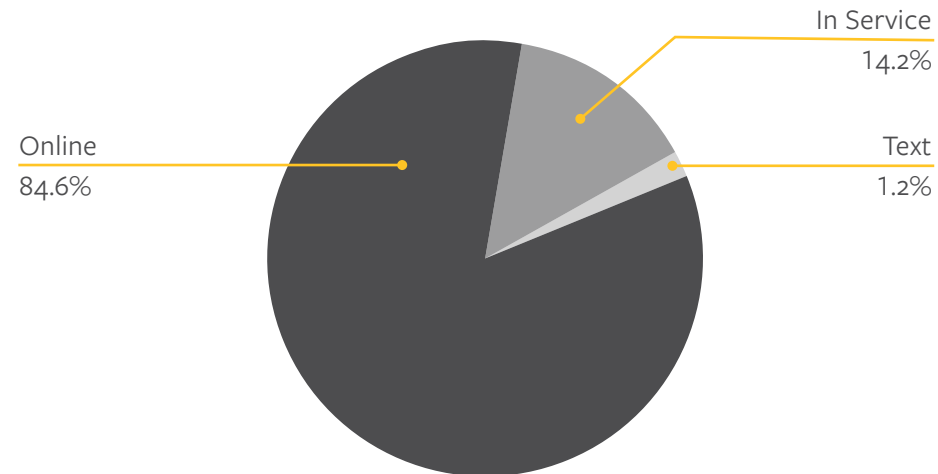

#### OUR FINANCIAL GOVERNANCE PRINCIPLES

- Liberty Church is a registered 501(c)(3) charity with bylaws that govern how we operate and make decisions as a church.
- When you tithe and give offerings as a member of Liberty Church, you can be confident that we are making every penny count. Your giving is confidential and is only seen by the Finance and Executive Teams.
- We use accountants who are not members of Liberty Church to ensure professionalism and transparency on a regular basis.
- Our day-to-day finances are administered by in-house bookkeepers who report to the Board.
- The Board approves an annual budget and receives detailed monthly financial reports.
- Each year 20-25% of the total giving that comes into our church we in turn sow into missions both locally and globally. This currently includes the Association of Related Churches, planting Liberty Churches, Children's Cup, benevolence, disaster relief and more.
- Each January we release an Annual Report outlining our financial performance and allocation of funds for the previous year.
