K-3 LARGE GROUP: Story (25 minutes) • Worship (10 minutes)

Engage kids' hearts through a dynamic and interactive Bible story, worship, and prayer experience in a Large group setting.

WONDER TRUTH: God Wants Us to Worship with Our Whole Lives
SCRIPTURE: Deuteronomy 6
GOD'S BIG STORY: Moses reminds the Israelites of God's good instructions as they enter their new land. They are to love God with all their heart, soul, and strength, worshiping Him with their whole selves.
WORD OF WONDER: Worship the LORD with gladness. Come to him with songs of joy. —Psalm 100:2

HOST: Our Wonder Truth today is GOD WANTS US TO WORSHIP WITH OUR WHOLE LIVES. Where did you see our Wonder Truth in the story? Allow kids to answer freely.

Many years after Moses told the people God's command to love Him with all their heart, soul, and strength, Jesus repeated Moses' words and said it is the "first and greatest commandment" (Matthew 22:38, NIV). Living for God means living a life of worship, and the Holy Spirit—God's presence with followers of Jesus—helps us live this way!

HOST: Our Word of Wonder reminds us that God deserves our worship. We can worship Him with joy and with gladness and with our whole lives, like we learned about. Open your Bible to Deuteronomy 6 and point to it. In God's big story today, we learned about loving God with our heart, soul, and strength. We learned that we can worship God when we get up, when we lie down, when we walk along the road, and even when we go into our houses. Let's practice learning the Word of Wonder while we do those things!
