# **BIBLE STORY Video**

HOST: Our Wonder Truth today is GOD LOVES WHEN WE WORSHIP WITH OUR WHOLE HEARTS. Where did you see our Wonder Truth in the story? Allow kids to answer freely.

David cared more about worshiping God than about himself. Though he was king, he knew that God is Lord. Many years later, Jesus came as the everlasting King—God as a human. Jesus is worthy of all our praise. And like David, we can honor Jesus with our worship!
