

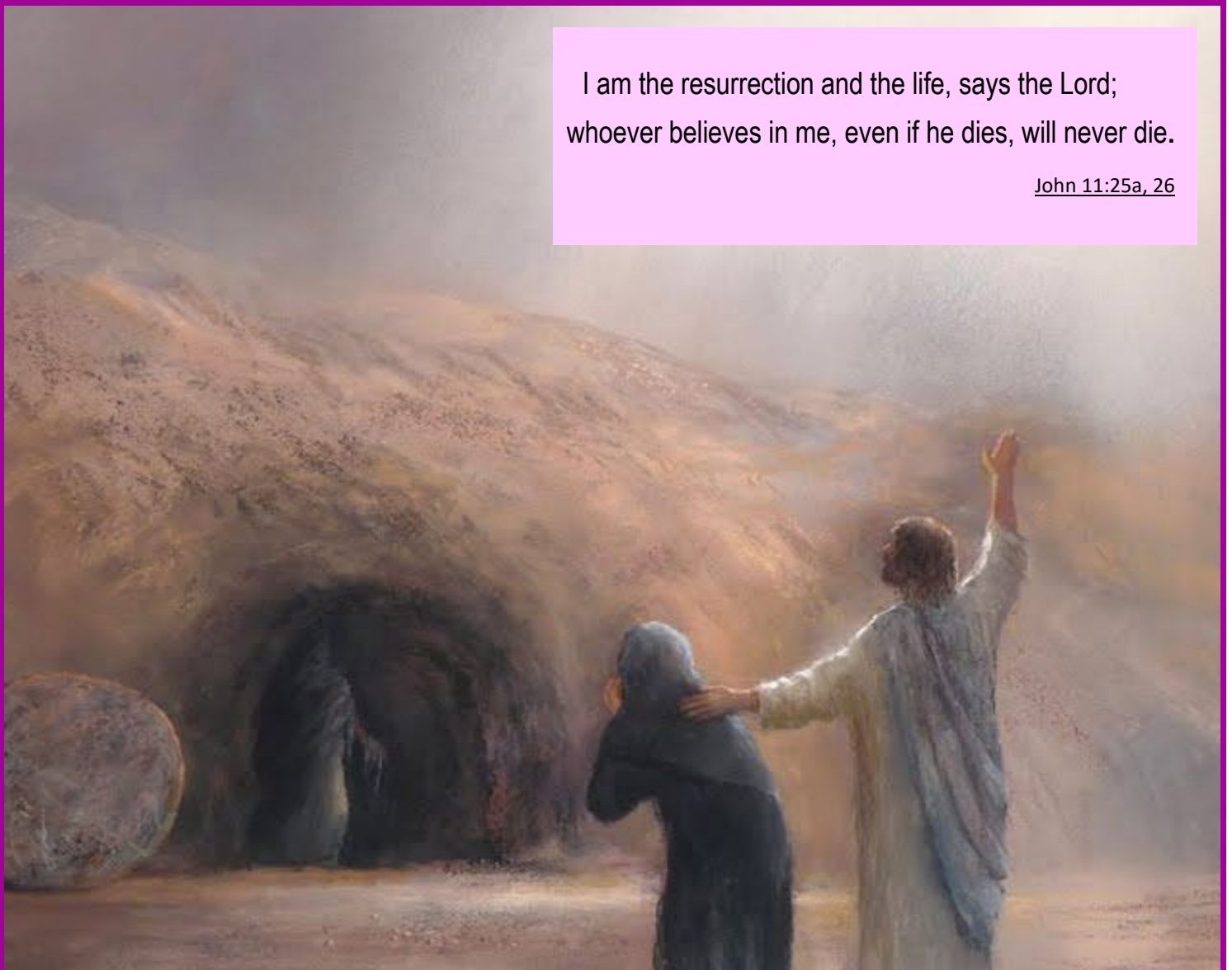

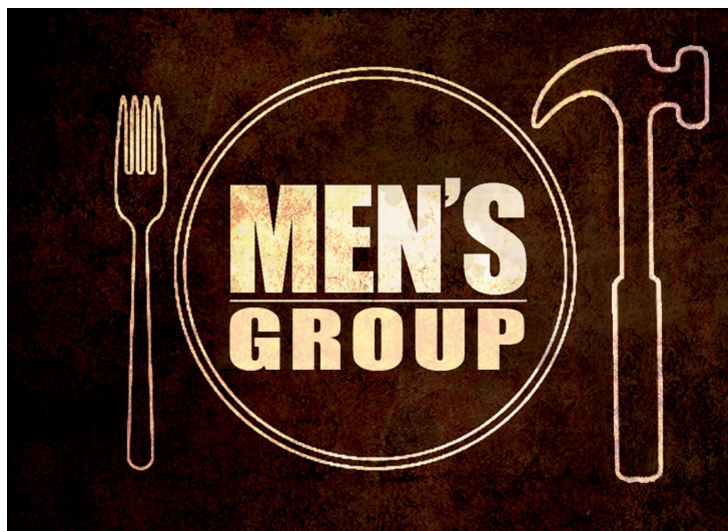


- There will be NO Daily Mass on Tuesday, March 24th. Fr. Franklin will be attending the Chrism Mass.

Bulletin Article: The Altar—Place of Sacrifice and Presence

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In our journey through the Mass, inspired by the teachings of Father

Rocky, we reflect today on the profound meaning of the altar.

From the Old Testament, the altar was always the place of sacrifice. Think of Abraham n Mount Moriah, offering his son in obedience to God. The altar was where heaven touched earth, where trust, surrender, and covenant were made.

Because of this sacred presence, the Church teaches that the tabernacle should be clearly visible, noble, beautiful, safe, and secure. In many churches it is placed in the center of the sanctuary and can only be opened with a key, reminding us of the great reverence due to the Eucharist.

In the New Testament, this meaning is fulfilled in Jesus Christ. Christ Himself is the cornerstone, and the altar represents Him, the place where the perfect sacrifice of the Cross is made present again at every Mass. This is why the altar is central to our worship.

The altar is not just a table; it is sacred. It is often made

of stone, strong and immovable, reminding us that Christ is our firm foundation. It is covered with linen, recalling how during Mass, the priest kisses the altar as a sign of reverence, because it represents Christ Himself. Here, bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus. Here, heaven meets earth.

Therefore, when we come to Mass, let us focus our hearts on the altar. Let us look upon it with faith, reverence, and love. For it is here that Christ offers Himself for us, again and again, out of love.

May we never lose our sense of awe before this sacred mystery.

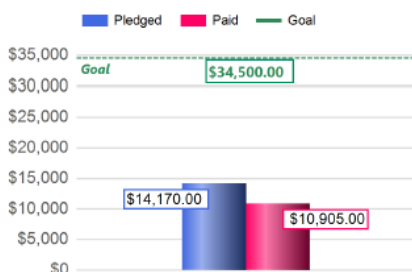
