THE SOLEMNITY OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE

Recognizing the King in the Eucharist

This weekend we celebrate the final Sunday of the liturgical year: the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, often simply called the Feast of Christ the King. It is a celebration that draws our attention to the sovereignty of Christ over all creation, His victory over sin and death, and His rightful place at the center of our lives. This feast is relatively new in the Church's liturgical calendar. In fact, this year marks the



100th anniversary of Quas Primas, the encyclical issued by Pope Pius XI in 1925 that formally established the celebration. Writing in a time of rising secularism, atheism, and the rejection of Christian values from public life, Pope Pius XI saw clearly that societies which push Jesus Christ and His holy law aside inevitably fall into discord and division. As the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops explains, the Holy Father instituted this solemnity to proclaim boldly that while "governments come and go, Christ reigns as king forever" (USCCB.org). Jesus Christ, the Pope wrote, "is very truth, and it is from Him truth must be obediently received by all mankind" (Quas Primas, 7).

Christ's kingship is rooted in the mystery of the Incarnation. Jesus is fully God and fully man, one Person of the Trinity who assumed our human nature. Because of this divine union, the Church teaches that Christ is Lord of all creation: "not only... to be adored by angels and men," but also that all creation "must recognize His empire" (Quas Primas, 13). His kingship is not distant or abstract; it is deeply personal. He reigns over the universe, yet He also desires to reign in the human heart.

Pope Pius XI was clear about what this means for us: "He must reign in our minds... in our wills... in our hearts... and in our bodies," shaping the way we think, choose, love, and live (Quas Primas, 33).

A Wake-Up Call From Our Own Sanctuary

This message becomes especially urgent for us as a parish because of a painful incident last Sunday: after Mass, the Eucharist was found on the floor of our church. This should trouble us deeply. Whether dropped accidentally or carelessly, it reveals a growing need for Eucharistic reverence, catechesis, and awareness. On this feast of Christ the King, we are invited to ask ourselves: Do we truly recognize our King when He comes to us in the Eucharist? If Jesus Christ is King of the Universe, Lord of heaven and earth, then He is also King

hidden in the humble form of bread. The same Christ who reigns in glory sits upon the altar at every Mass. The same Jesus whom angels adore is placed into our hands or on our tongue. The same Lord who will judge the nations dwells in our tabernacle. If we believe this, then every Host must be received with awe. Every moment in His presence should move us to humility and love. And every time we approach Holy Communion, our hearts must whisper, "My Lord and my King."

Renewing Our Eucharistic Reverence

As we close the liturgical year and prepare to enter Advent, this solemnity invites us to return wholeheartedly to Christ our King, especially in the Most Blessed Sacrament. Let us renew:

Our reverence in receiving Holy Communion

Our attention to the sacred presence of Christ

Our responsibility to ensure no Host is ever mishandled or left behind

Our love for the King who gives Himself completely to us

May this feast strengthen our faith, heal our indifference, and open our eyes to the King

who reigns from the throne of the Cross—and from the altar in our very midst.

Christ the King, reign in our hearts. Christ the King, reign in our parish. Christ the King, reign forever.




