“I Love Christmas... and So What?”

Someone once joked that Christmas is the only time of year when people will sit in traffic for an hour just to park far away, walk in the cold, and still say, “This is my favorite season!” We love the lights, the music, the food, the family gatherings. But Christmas asks us a deeper question: *I love Christmas, so what does that actually mean for my faith and my life?*



According to the **USCCB (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops)**,

Christmas celebrates the profound mystery of the **Incarnation**, God becoming human in Jesus Christ. This is not a display of power, but of humility. God comes to us not as a warrior or king, but as a vulnerable child. Christmas is the feast of *Emmanuel*, “God-with-us,” God entering fully into our human story out of love.

Today’s readings proclaim that this is truly **Good News**. Isaiah joyfully announces, “How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of the one who brings good news” (Isaiah 52:7). Christmas is that good news made visible. Psalm 98 invites all the earth to sing because the Lord has revealed His saving power. In the Letter to the Hebrews, we hear that while God spoke in many ways through the prophets, now He speaks definitively through His Son (Hebrews 1:1–6). And in the Gospel of John, we are taken to the very heart of Christmas: “The Word became flesh and dwelt among us” (John 1:14).

So how do we benefit from Christmas? One powerful way is by **fully entering into the celebration of the Masses of Christmas as individuals and as families**. Each Mass—Christmas Vigil, Midnight, Dawn, and Day, reveals a different facet of the mystery. Attending Mass is not simply fulfilling an obligation; it is participating personally in the Lord’s Incarnation. When families come together to worship, children learn that Christmas is not only about receiving gifts, but about receiving *Christ*.

The USCCB reminds us that Christmas is second only to Easter in importance because it marks God’s entry into human history. God chooses to be close to us, to share our joys and struggles, our hopes and fears. The Nativity scene and Christmas tree are not just decorations; they are catechisms in wood and light. They teach us that life, hope, and salvation come through humility and love.

“I love Christmas”, so what? It means choosing faith over distraction, worship over convenience, and charity over self-centeredness. It means trusting God as the Holy Family did, even when the journey is uncertain. It means allowing the Child of Bethlehem to change our hearts.

This Christmas, let us not only celebrate the season, let us **encounter the Savior**. Come to Mass. Bring your family. Open your heart. God has come to dwell among us. And that changes everything.

FOOD pantry




