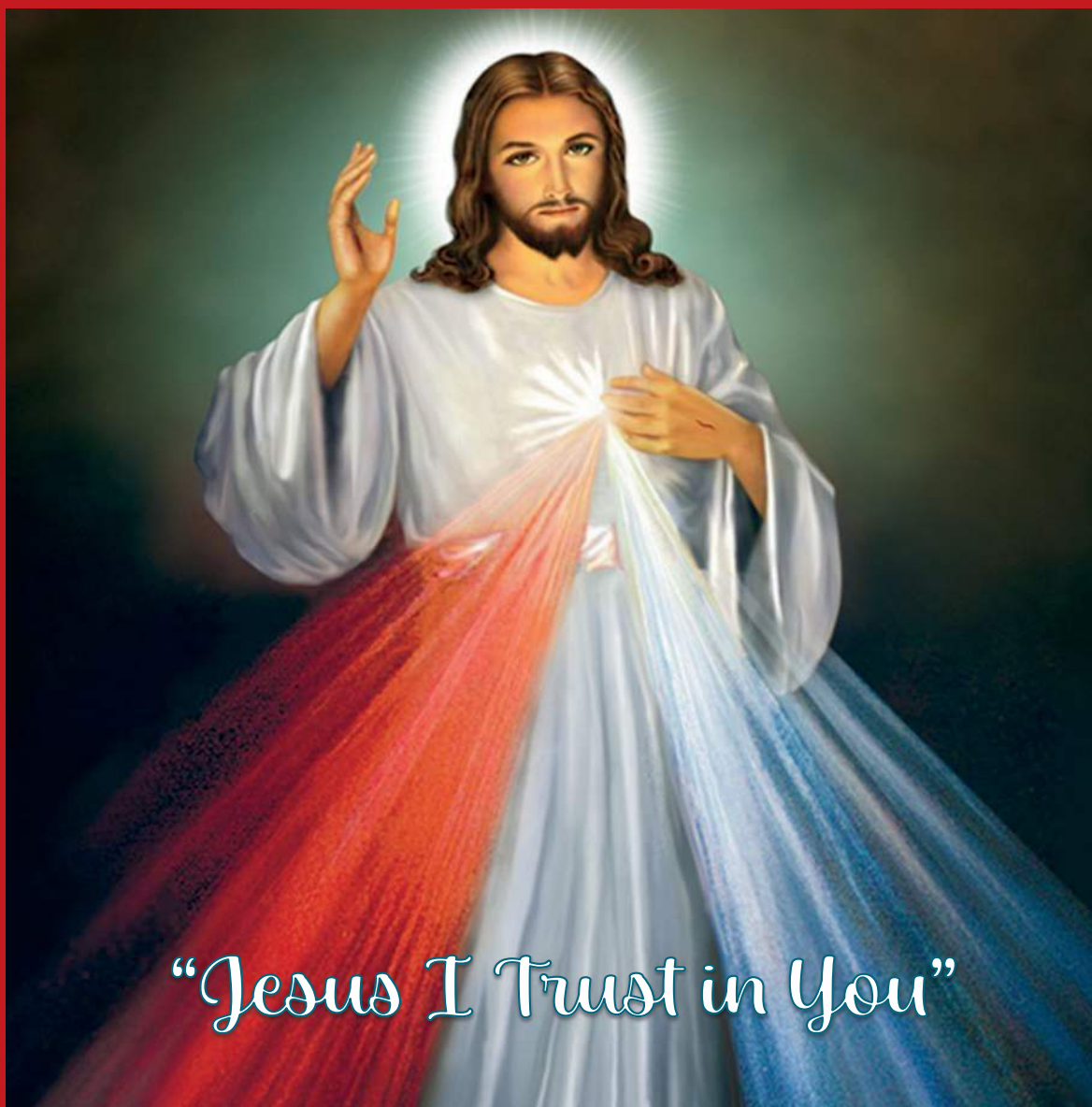

Parish Bulletin Article.
Divine Mercy Sunday
Theme: "Jesus, I Trust in You"

A little boy once broke his mother's favorite vase. Afraid, he hid in his room, expecting anger and punishment. But instead, his mother came, sat beside him, and said, "I'm not happy about the vase, but I love you more than anything." The boy ran into her arms, not because he deserved it, but because he was loved. That is Divine Mercy.

A Brief History

Divine Mercy Sunday was established for the universal Church by Pope John Paul II in the year 2000, on the day he canonized Saint Faustina Kowalska. However, the devotion began earlier through the private revelations given to Sister Faustina, a humble Polish nun in the 1930s.

Jesus revealed to her His burning desire that the world come to know His mercy. He asked that the Sunday after Easter be celebrated as the Feast of Divine Mercy, a day when His love and forgiveness would be poured out in an extraordinary way.

The Promise of Divine Mercy. Jesus made a powerful promise: "The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment."

This is not just another devotion, it is a lifeline. It is as if Jesus is saying: "Come back to Me, no matter how far you have gone." What Attracted Saint Faustina?. What captivated Saint Faustina Kowalska was not just the message, but the Heart behind it. She encountered a Jesus who was not distant or condemning, but tender, patient, and full of compassion. She saw rays of red and pale light flowing from His Heart, symbols of blood and water, signs of life, healing, and grace.

She realized that God's greatest attribute is not justice, but mercy.

The Heart of Jesus Explained

The Heart of Jesus is not just a symbol, it is the very center of His love for humanity. It is a Heart that: Forgives sinners .Heals the broken. Seeks the lost. Never gives up on us.

When we say, "Jesus, I trust in You," we are placing our entire lives, our sins, fears, and struggles, into that merciful Heart.

What Does This Mean for Us Today?

Many people today carry hidden wounds: guilt, regret, fear, and hopelessness. Divine Mercy Sunday reminds us: No sin is greater than God's mercy. No past is beyond redemption. No suffering is meaningless when united to Christ. **For those who feel lost or unworthy, this feast is especially for you.**

How Do We Celebrate This Feast?

We are invited to:

- Go to Confession (before or on this day)
- Receive the Holy Eucharist worthily
- Pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet
- Reflect at 3:00 PM, the Hour of Mercy
- Show mercy to others through acts of kindness and forgiveness
- Light from the Sunday Readings

Acts 2:42–47: The early Church lived in unity, sharing everything. Mercy builds community. When we receive mercy, we become merciful to others.

1 Peter 1:3–9: Even in trials, we rejoice because we have a living hope. Mercy gives us hope beyond suffering—it reminds us that pain is not the end of our story.

John 20:19–31: Jesus appears to the disciples and says, "Peace be with you." He shows His wounds, not to condemn, but to heal. To Thomas, who doubted, Jesus offers not rejection, but mercy.

A Message for the Suffering and the Sinner

If you are struggling... if you feel far from God... if you carry burdens you think are too heavy, this is your feast. Jesus is not waiting to condemn you. He is waiting to embrace you.

His Heart is open. His mercy is endless. Come to Him.

Conclusion

Divine Mercy is not just a devotion, it is the very heart of the Gospel. It is the story of a God who never stops loving, never stops forgiving, and never stops seeking us.

This Sunday, let us not be afraid to return to Him.

Let us say with faith:
"Jesus, I trust in You."
