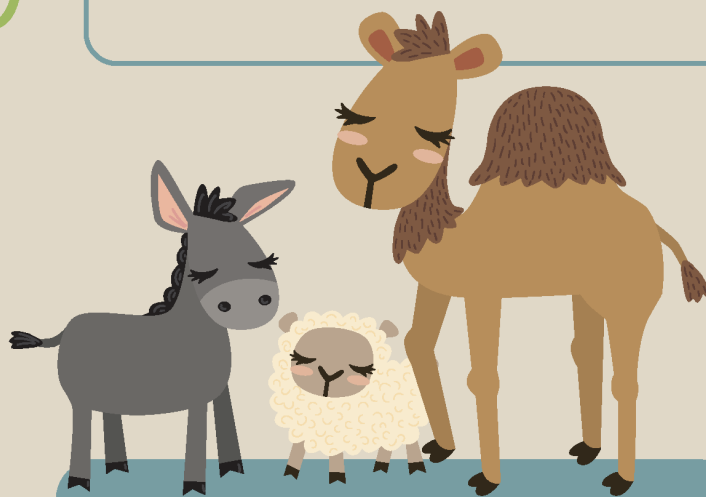
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THE Christmas STORY

"Then the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name JESUS."

LUKE 1:32-33

"He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end."

LUKE 1:35, 37

"And the angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God. For with God nothing will be impossible."

LUKE 1:38

"Then Mary said, "Behold, I am the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to your word." And the angel departed from her."

'But while he thought about these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit."
- 15** MATTHEW 1:21
"And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins."
- 16** MATTHEW 1:22-23
'So all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying: "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated, "God with us."

"Then Joseph, being aroused from sleep, did as the angel of the Lord commanded him and took to him his wife, and did not know her till she had brought forth her firstborn Son. And he called His name JESUS."

"And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn."
- 19** LUKE 2:8-9
"Now there were in the same country shepherds living out in the fields, keeping watch over their flock by night. And behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were greatly afraid."
- 20** LUKE 2:10-11
"Then the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people. For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is Christ the Lord."
- 21** LUKE 2:12-14
""And this will be the sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling cloths, lying in a manger." And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying: "Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace, goodwill toward men!"

'So it was, when the angels had gone away from them into heaven, that the shepherds said to one another, "Let us now go to Bethlehem and see this thing that has come to pass, which the Lord has made known to us."
- 23** LUKE 2:16-17
"And they came with haste and found Mary and Joseph, and the Babe lying in a manger. Now when they had seen Him, they made widely known the saying which was told them concerning this Child."
- 24** GALATIANS 4:4-5
"But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons."

Your kids will love making this sweet treat from Dinner at the Zoo! Getting the giggles is guaranteed when smashing up the candy canes!

This makes a perfect gift especially when including the *Legend of the Candy Cane*!

Peppermint Bark

12 ounces semisweet chocolate chips

16 ounces white chocolate chips or
chopped white chocolate

1/2 teaspoon peppermint extract

3/4 cup crushed candy canes



- 1 Place the semisweet chocolate chips in a medium bowl and microwave for 30 second increments until melted. Stir until smooth.
- 2 Spread the chocolate into a roughly 9x13 rectangle on a piece of parchment paper. Place the chocolate in the fridge for 10 minutes to partially set. Do NOT go past 10 minutes in the fridge. The chocolate should be just set around the edges but still partially melted in the middle. If you let the semisweet layer harden completely, the white chocolate may not stick to it.
- 3 Place the white chocolate chips in a medium bowl and microwave for 30 second increments until melted. Add the peppermint extract and stir until smooth.
- 4 Spread the white chocolate over the semisweet chocolate layer. Top with candy canes. Let harden in the fridge for about 20 minutes or until the chocolate is completely set.
- 5 Remove from the fridge and let the bark sit at room temperature for about 20 minutes. Use a straight edge chef's knife to cut the bark into pieces by cutting straight down through the layers of the bark. *Serve and enjoy.*



THE Legend of the Candy Cane

This is a great story to help your kids remember JESUS all season long! It is also a great way to witness to our friends and neighbors. Bring a gift of peppermint bark or simple candy canes along with the following cut-out tied up with a ribbon and spread Christmas JOY through the gospel!



THE Legend of the Candy Cane

Long ago, a candymaker created a treat to tell others about Christ! When you enjoy a candy cane, take a moment to remember **JESUS** and His gift!

The Shepherd's Staff: The candy maker made the candy cane in the shape of a shepherd's staff. Jesus is the good shepherd to his flock! (Psalm 23:1, John 10:11, John 10:27-30, Isaiah 40:11)

The Letter J for Jesus: When held upside down, it also formed a "J," for Jesus. (Luke 1:31, Matthew 1:21)

He is A Rock: The candy cane is a hard candy, which was to remind children that Jesus is our "rock." (Psalm 31:3)

By His Stripes: Wide red stripes were added to the candy cane, representing the blood Jesus shed for our sins. Through his blood, we are given salvation and eternal life. (Revelation 1:5, John 3:16, Luke 22:20)

White-Purification from Sin: The white stripes on the candy cane, represent the holiness, and purity of Jesus, who was sinless. (1 John 1:7)



Broken For Us: The candy cane is often broken, reminding us that when Jesus was crucified, his body was broken. (1 Cor. 11:24)

Love of Christ: The candy cane was also made to be given as a gift! This reminds us of the love of Jesus who gave us the gift of salvation. (John 3:16)
