




Missions:



Pray for believers & missions in Algeria. Pop: 47,435,312. The growth of the Algerian Church over the past decade is an answer to prayer! Many years of hard work by missionaries and praying people produced beautiful fruit. Most believers come from a Kabyle Berber background, but faith grows among Arabs and most other people groups as well. The Christian community enjoys a spirit of unity, which stands out from the long history of conflict among ethnic groups. New fellowships began throughout Algeria, partly because Berber believers moved into unreached Arab areas with the Gospel. 97% Muslim; 0.2% Evangelical Christian; 59% Unengaged; 22 Languages Spoken; 38 People Groups
