WSC Discipline Policy

➤ Level 1 Infractions:

- **Administrative – Signing in & out**
- **Filling out one day member forms completely**
- **Not policing range before leaving (includes policing brass both inside and outside of the shooting areas).**
- **Use of eye and ear protection**
- **Violation of range shooting hours**
- **Improper use of cease fire lights**

➤ Level 2 Infractions:

- **Shooting Shotguns at the rifle range backers**
- **Improper target placement on Rifle range backers**
- **Use of non-approved targets**
- **Violation of one day members policy**
- **Improper firearm handling**
- **Placing movable targets in front of the 25-yard berm on the rifle range except for the provisions provided in the range rules.**
- **Loading or closing the action of a firearm when not on the firing line.**
- **Handling firearms, magazines or ammunition when cease fire light is on.**



➤ **Level 3 Infractions:**

- **Use of explosive targets**
- **Use of a rifle or pistol caliber carbine at the pistol range**
- **Violations of caliber restrictions on the pistol range**
- **Shooting from in front of the rifle or pistol sheds.**
- **Violation of Full Auto Policy.**
- **Use of armor piercing or armor penetrating ammunition on steel targets.**
- **Use of Firearms greater than a .50 caliber center fire standard load .50 caliber BMG ammo is not allowed. Muzzle loaders are exempt from this rule.**
- **Use of alcohol or drugs before or during range use.**

Level 1 or 2 infractions will be handled in a verbal reminder of the pertinent range rule. Three verbal warnings for the same infraction will result in a written warning placed in the member's file.

Level 3 infractions will result in a written warning placed in the member's file.

Three written warnings will result in a hearing in front of the WSC Board which could result in suspension of range privileges for 1 month. Followed by completion of a basic firearms course prior to reinstatement.

Further written warnings will result in a second hearing in front of the WSC Board which could result in a longer suspension or being expelled from the club permanently.
