Full Auto Device Policy

The Winnipesaukee Sportsmen's club bans fully automatic firearms as well the use of bump stocks, binary triggers, forced reset triggers or any other device duplicating or nearly duplicating full auto for the following reasons:

- **Safety risks:** The rapid-fire action of a bump stock can lead to a lack of control and accuracy, increasing the risk of stray bullets hitting the range ceiling, target frames, or other unintended areas. Ranges typically have strict rules on controlled firing to maintain safety.
- **Damage to property:** The high rate of fire can damage range equipment and property, such as the ground stands and target frames.
- **Excessive noise:** The noise from rapid firing can be a disturbance to other shooters at the range.
