



SOP for Handgun Comprehensive Shoot

1. Open storage cabinet in pistol shed. Remove the 4 C-clamps and the 4 popper targets.
2. Unlock and position the plate rack just to the left and even with the left-hand dueling tree.
3. Position a target stand just to the left and even with the plate rack. Place 2 upright pieces of strapping in the target stand then using the 4 clamps place 2 pieces of strapping horizontally one on top of the other about 2 feet apart vertically. Staple 3 paper plates from left to right across the top piece of strapping and 2 paper plates on the bottom piece of strapping (make sure no paper plates are in front of the support post for the hanging steel targets).
4. Hammer the 4 popper targets into the ground evenly spaced beneath the plate rack (not in front of the plate racks wheels).
5. Paint all the hanging steel targets, the plate rack targets and the poppers with a fresh coat of paint.
6. Retrieve handgun shoot storage bin from the cabinet and set up Event log sheet.
7. As shooters arrive, have them sign in, pay for the event, \$5 for both stages or 1 punch on their punch card and give them a raffle ticket. If a shooter needs a new punch card, the cost is \$40. Place money in index box located in the storage bin.
8. As shooters uncase their firearms make sure the actions are open, an empty chamber indicator is in place. Make sure handguns are placed on the left rear shelf and ammunition and magazines are on the right rear shelf.
9. At the start time, set up the Score sheet.
10. Read and assign duties from the event log sheet.

11. Read event safety briefing & course of fire notice.
12. As a shooter is called to the line, carefully monitor the shooter. Action open, Empty chamber indicator in place & muzzle control either up or downrange.
13. Monitor Shooter as they stage Firearms and magazines at the proper shooting bays according to the course of fire instructions
14. Give range commands to start the shooters.
15. Monitor shooters throughout the stage for safety.
16. After the cease fire is called carefully monitor the shooter as they secure their firearms and return them to the correct shelves (handguns on the left, magazines on the right). Muzzle control, action open & empty chamber indicator in place.
17. When the firearms are secured, activate cease fire light and instruct shooters to go downrange and reset the targets. No Handling of firearms, magazines or ammunition while cease fire light is on.
18. Fill out the score sheet using the provided hit/miss table to calculate adjusted time from raw time.
19. When everyone has returned from downrange call the range hot and call the next shooter to the line. Repeat steps 12 -18.
20. When all shooters have shot the stage, declare the winner.
21. For the second stage repeat steps 12-19
22. When all shooters have shot the second stage, declare the winner and draw one raffle ticket. The ticket holder drawn receives a free round.
23. When all shooters have shot the rimfire round declare the overall winner and draw one raffle ticket. The ticket holder drawn receives a free round.
24. Call a cease fire and move all items back to their proper storage location and secure locations.
