
#### You're It!

Ask some friends to play a game of freeze tag. Take turns being "it." After playing a few rounds think through some of these questions:

KNOW that Jesus included everyone.





# Even When It's Hard

Close your eyes and draw a picture of someone you respect. It's hard to draw with your eyes closed, isn't it? But while you were drawing you always saw in your mind exactly what they looked like even if it didn't really look like them. Remember, even when it's hard, you can respect others like Jesus would.

LOOK for ways that you can show others they are important by what you say and do.

### Look Out For Others

Look up Philippians 2:4 and read it aloud with someone in your home. Talk through some ways you can look out for the good of others tomorrow at school, in your home, or neighborhood.

ASK Jesus to help you see the needs of others.



### **Bring Them In**

Pray and ask Jesus to help you be friends with others. You can come up with your own prayer or pray something like this:

"Dear Jesus, Today I come to you praying that you will make it clear to me when someone needs a friend. I pray for the courage to reach out to them and bring them in. I pray I can show your love by the way I treat them. Amen."

THANK Jesus for being the best example of a friend who brings others in.

### So Important!

Jesus lived to show others how important they are. God created everyone for a purpose and that plays an important role in life. Who are some important people in your life? A teacher? A family member? Someone from church? Write their names on a piece of paper using red, then trace over it with each color of the rainbow. Hang it somewhere you can be reminded how they make you feel.

ASK Jesus to help you show others they are important this week.



### Be A Friend

Draw a picture of you and one of your friends or siblings. In the picture draw a scene of what it looks like when you are getting along! Hang the picture in your room to remind you to always be a friend.

KNOW that everyone needs a friend.





### **Look Out**

Have an adult help you write out this week's verse on a white board or chalk board. Say the verse aloud erasing a word or words after every time you say it until most of the verse is erased.

LOOK for ways to look out for the good of others.



## Let's Get Along

Sometimes it's hard to get along with others. Getting along while showing respect can even be harder! Pray the prayer below and ask Jesus for help.

"Dear Jesus, I pray today that you can help me when I'm not getting along with someone. I pray that I can learn to be respectful but have the strength to do and say what I need to. I pray that I can always shows others they are important to me by the way I treat them. Amen"

THANK God for helping you see others as important.

Show respect even when you don't get along.

With the permission of an adult, ask a friend to meet you for a play-date sometime this week. When you and your friend get together, try and do things that show them they are important to you. You can do things like have their favorite snack or play their favorite game! Write who you want to invite in the space below.

How has someone shown you that you are important? Draw a picture of yourself and someone else who makes you feel important. If you can, show the person what you drew and thank them for making you feel important!

THANK people who make you feel important.

KNOW that honoring others in love is what Jesus would do.



### **Be A Mary**

In the story of Mary and Martha, Mary was sitting and listening to Jesus while Martha was running around. It takes a lot of patience to be like Mary. Pray and ask Jesus to help you be more like Mary.


