SEA OF GALILEE



JERUSALEM

Day 1 – Departure

Depart from Atlanta International Airport and begin your spiritual journey.

Day 2 – Arrival in Israel | Caesarea | Mt. Carmel | Galilee

Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport, where our team will meet and assist you.

On the way to your hotel in Galilee, visit Caesarea Maritima, reflecting on the Acts of the Apostles and the early church. See the ancient aqueduct, then continue to Mount Carmel, recalling Elijah's confrontation with the prophets of Baal.

Enjoy a traditional Druze lunch (our treat) before driving to Galilee. Check in at the Leonardo Hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 3 – Nazareth | Caesarea Philippi | Nain | Mt. Tabor | Megiddo

After breakfast, travel to Caesarea Philippi and share in a reflection on Matthew 16:18. Visit the waterfalls, then continue to Nazareth to see the Basilica of the Annunciation and Mount Precipice.

Stop in Nain, the village of the widow, and proceed to Mount Tabor, the site of the Transfiguration. Visit Megiddo, sharing Revelation 16:16.

Return to Galilee for dinner and overnight, traveling along the ancient trail Jesus walked from Nazareth to Capernaum.

Day 4 – Galilee | Capernaum | Jordan River

After breakfast, visit the Mount of Beatitudes for worship and reflection. Continue to Tabgha, the multiplication site, and Peter's Primacy, where we'll hold a Vow Renewal on the shore of the Galilee.

Explore Capernaum, including the synagogue, Greek Orthodox Monastery and the ancient boat. Enjoy a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, pausing in the middle of the lake for worship and quiet reflection.

Conclude at the Jordan River Baptismal Site for a renewal of baptism. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 5 – Beit Shean | Bethlehem | Jerusalem

After breakfast and check-out, visit the remarkable ruins of Beit Shean, one of the best-preserved Roman cities.

Drive through the Jordan Valley and enter Jerusalem with joy. Continue to Bethlehem to visit the Church of the Nativity, explore the ancient caves beneath it, and see the Shepherds' Field. Hear the stories of David the shepherd, Ruth and Boaz, and Luke 2. Check in to your Jerusalem hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 6 – Jerusalem | Mount of Olives | Israel Museum & Holocaust Museum

After breakfast, begin the day at the Western Wall, the Teaching Steps, and the Davidson Archaeological Gardens.

Continue to St. Anne's Church and the Pools of Bethesda, then ascend the Mount of Olives, walking the historic Palm Sunday path to Gethsemane.

Visit the Israel Museum, including the Jerusalem Model and the Shrine of the Book, and spend time at the Holocaust Museum.

Pause at the Valley of Elah, where David faced Goliath, before returning to your hotel for dinner. In the evening, enjoy a complimentary walking tour of Jerusalem with your guide.

Day 7 – Masada | Ein Gedi | Qumran | Jericho | Baptismal Site

After breakfast, travel to Masada and ascend the ancient fortress while hearing its powerful story. Continue to Qumran, then explore the Ein Gedi Caves, where David once sought refuge from Saul.

Travel to Jericho to view the Mount of Temptation and the wilderness road that Jesus traveled toward Jerusalem.

Pause at the Jordan River baptismal site before returning to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 8 – Old City of Jerusalem

After breakfast, explore the Old City of Jerusalem, walking the Via Dolorosa and discovering the hidden caves beneath the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. View the ancient Broad Wall of Hezekiah before continuing to the Upper Room and David's Tomb. Visit Caiaphas' House and the prison where Jesus was held, then see the Essenes Gate.

Conclude the day at the Citadel Museum, offering one of the finest views of Jerusalem. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 9 – Jaffa | Emmaus | Garden Tomb

After breakfast, journey to Jaffa, the ancient port of Tel Aviv. Visit Simon the Tanner's house, reflect on Peter's experiences in Acts, and wander through the old port.

On the way back to Jerusalem, stop at Emmaus before visiting the Garden Tomb for a meaningful communion service celebrating your pilgrimage.

Enjoy a free late afternoon in Jerusalem, then return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 10 – Until We Meet Again

After breakfast, check out and transfer to the airport for your flight home. For those with evening departures, a farewell dinner will be arranged before your transfer.
