How to Use the Pittsburgh Prays Map

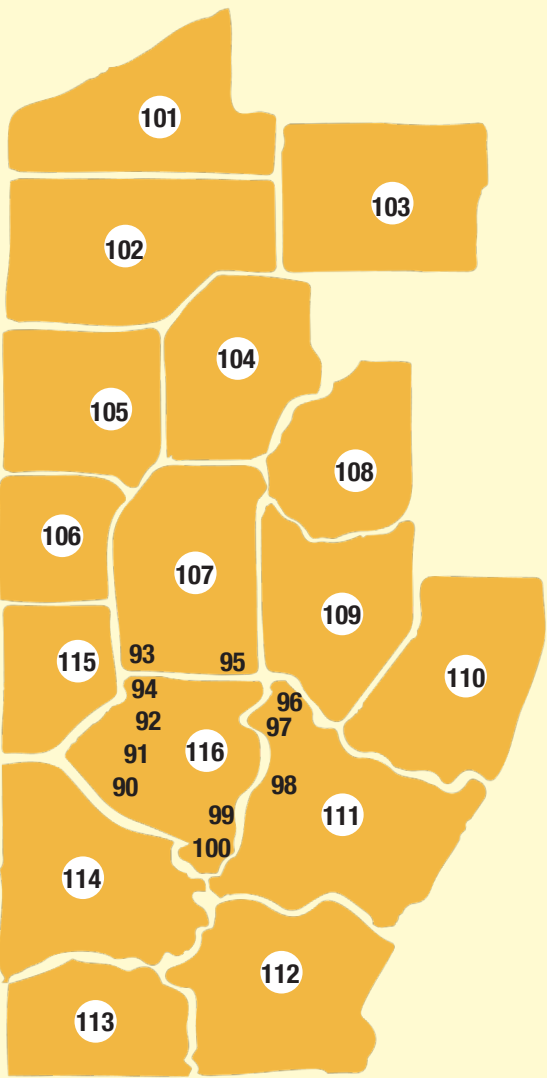
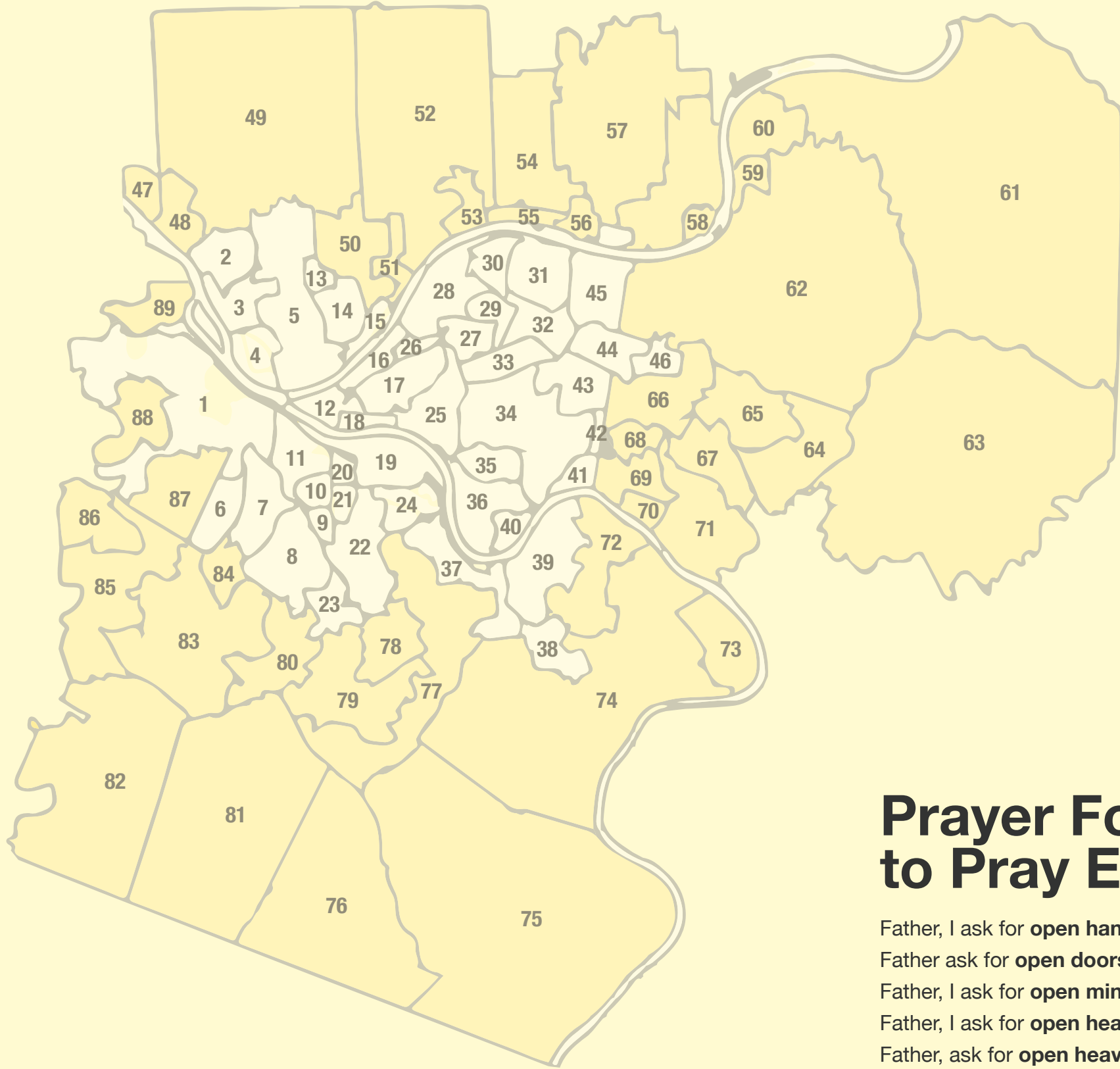
This map has been created to help you cover the city of Pittsburgh and the surrounding region with prayer each month as you intercede for each community as well as the daily prayer focus provided below.

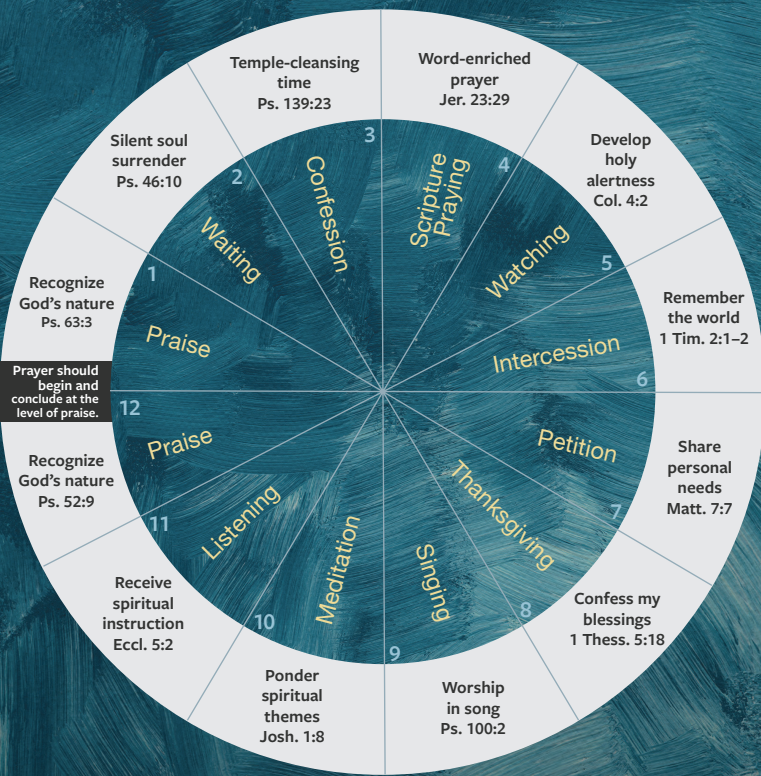
