

Summary

In Daniel 2:1-23, Nebuchadnezzar is troubled by a dream and summons magicians, enchanters, sorcerers, and astrologers to explain it, but none can.

Nebuchadnezzar demands they tell him both the dream and its meaning, offering great reward if they succeed and death if they fail.

When the advisors admit the task is impossible for any human on Earth, he orders all the wise men in Babylon to be executed.

When Arioch comes for Daniel, Daniel seeks to understand this harsh decree and asks the king for time to interpret the dream. He also gathers Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah urging them to pray and plead for mercy.

That night, God reveals the mystery to Daniel in a vision, and Daniel responds with praise, exalting God for His wisdom, power and revelation.
