Safety Protocol

DELIVERING PACKAGES SAFELY
PLEASE TAKE THIS SERIOUSLY
STRICT ADHERENCE TO THIS PROTOCOL PROTECTS YOU AND THOSE WE ARE
SERVING

1. Do not volunteer today if you have fever/cough/shortness of breath. If you feel sick or have been exposed to a sick person, or have a condition that puts you at higher risk, stay home.
2. Wear clean gloves when handling packages. Wash your hands with soap and water after removing gloves or use hand sanitizer until you can.
3. Wear a clean mask if you have one. Do not touch your face, nose, mouth or eyes while handling packages.
4. Leave package outside the recipient's door, then back away by 10 feet.
5. Phone receiving party to inform them that the package is delivered and ask them if they would like you to leave or would like to speak with you. Do not drive away until you have communicated with the recipient.
6. Smile: Ask them how they are feeling; Ask them if they would like prayer, but stay 10 feet away!
7. .Change gloves/use hand sanitizer/ disposable wipes between every package delivery.
8. Respectfully follow all other safety protocols by the ministry you are serving.
