Safety Protocol

ASSEMBLING MANNA/FOOD BAGS SAFELY

PLEASE TAKE THIS SERIOUSLY

STRICT ADHERENCE TO THIS PROTOCOL PROTECTS YOU AND THOSE WE ARE

SERVING

1. Do not volunteer today if you have fever/cough/shortness of breath. If you feel sick or have been exposed to a sick person, or have a condition that puts you at higher risk, stay home.
2. Wash your hands with soap and water or hand sanitizer before you begin.
3. All items put into the bag should be in sealed packaging. Wrap the plastic spoons/fork in a paper towel before adding them to the bag.
4. The following items should be inserted into a one-gallon size re-sealable plastic bag:
 - Sealed cracker packs (peanut butter, cheese, etc.)
 - Granola Bars
 - Tuna in pouches
 - Anything in pop top cans, Vienna sausages and canned fruit, for example
 - Plastic spoon(s)/fork(s)
 - Fruit snacks
 - Beef jerky
 - Nuts
 - Protein drinks
 - Chewing gum
 - Do not include money but feel free to add a note of encouragement.
5. Place the completed hygiene kits in the black donation bins outside the Highway Building or behind the kitchen.
