

VBS Volunteer Jobs

We need many volunteers to make VBS successful. There are many ways you can serve God by serving His children during VBS Week. A few things...we will fill all adult spots before we pair up adults. You can put down a name of someone you'd like to work with, and we will try to take that into account when making assignments. We've put the number of volunteers needed beside each description.

Elementary VBS (Kinder-5th Grade)

Crew Leaders: This job is open to anyone who has finished sixth grade through adult. Kids will be in crews of 5 kids. Crew Leaders will each be responsible for one crew. They will lead their crews from station to station, ask questions, encourage participation, and get to know their crew members. They will also lead a discussion with their crew during snack time. Questions are provided. There is no planning, just relationship building. **Number Needed: 48**

Station Leaders: Groups will rotate between stations during their day at VBS. Station leaders are in charge of leading their station each day to four groups of 15 kids each. All lesson plans and materials provided. In some stations decorating the room is necessary. Station leaders are open to those who have finished 10th grade through adult. For Preschool Station Leaders see the back of this sheet.

Bible Adventure: Lead crews in discovering deeper meaning in each day's Bible story. This is hands on and experiential learning. Kids will become part of the Bible story with their hearts, minds, and emotions. Crew leaders will assist in leading discussions with their crews during this station. The room will need to be decorated and decorations change daily. **Number Needed: 4**

Kid-Vid Cinema: This station brings home each Bible point. In the daily videos kids get to "meet" five real kids who experienced the amazing power of Jesus. Your job as station leader is to show the video and give the crew leaders instructions to help lead a discussion in their crews. The room will need to be decorated. **Number Needed: 4**

Imagination Station: Imagination Station is where kids experiment, explore, test, try...and play! Each day, kids create a new gizmo that helps them understand the Bible point. The room will need to be decorated. **Number Needed: 4**

Game Station Leader: These leaders teach and lead students in games each day.
Number Needed: 2

Youth Station Assistants: Youth who have completed sixth grade can be station assistants in any of the stations. You would assist the lead teacher with teaching the lesson at that station. It is a great place for youth who want to eventually teach their own station. They can learn from a lead teacher and discover what it takes to run a station.

Preschool VBS (3- 5 year olds)

Crew Leaders: This job is open to anyone who has finished sixth grade through adult. Kids will be in crews of five kids. Crew Leaders will each be responsible for one crew. They will lead their crews from station to station, ask questions, encourage participation, and get to know their crew members. They will also lead a discussion with their crew during snack time. Questions are provided. There is no planning, just relationship building. **Number Needed: 12**

Preschool Station Leaders: Station leaders in Preschool will do two stations

Station 1: Exploration Station or Bible Adventures

Station 2: Kid-vid, Games, or Craft and Play

Total of 12 people

Exploration Station: Set up and run the hands-on stations for preschoolers. This is free choice time for preschoolers who will pick from a variety of themed stations. All plans and supplies are provided.

Bible Adventure: Lead crews in discovering deeper meaning in each day's Bible story. This is hands on and experiential learning. Kids will become part of the Bible story with their hearts, minds, and emotions. Crew leaders will assist in leading discussions with their crews during this station. The room will need to be decorated and decorations change daily.

Craft and Play: Lead preschoolers in the Imagination Station and craft options. There are multiple choices for crafts each day.

Kid-Vid Cinema: This station brings home each Bible point. In the daily videos kids get to "meet" five real kids who experienced the amazing power of Jesus. Your job as station leader is to show the video and give the crew leaders instructions to help lead a discussion in their crews. The room will need to be decorated.

Game Station Leader: These leaders teach and lead students in games each day.

Additional Assistance:

Substitutes: Emergencies do happen and we need a group of people willing to step in and fill in a spot if someone is unable to make it to VBS.

Information Tables: We need people to staff information and help tables on the first day of VBS. These people assist children in getting to their crews and help with any problems with t-shirts, registration, nametags, etc.

Scholarships: Some of our families cannot afford to pay the registration fee. One way to help is to donate all or part of a child's registration fee. You can write a check to St. Andrew's and put VBS Scholarship in the memo line.
