DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Peter thought forgiving “seven times” was generous, but Jesus said, “seventy-seven times”. What does this tell us about God’s perspective on forgiveness compared to our own?
2. The first servant’s debt would have taken roughly 165,000 years to repay. How does understanding the magnitude of God’s forgiveness change our perspective on the smaller debts others owe us?
3. Why do you think the forgiven servant immediately went out and refused to forgive his fellow servant’s much smaller debt?
4. Scientific studies indicate that forgiveness training reduces depression, anger, and various health problems, while unforgiveness increases risks for heart disease and other ailments. Have you experienced the physical or emotional toll of holding onto unforgiveness? How might this motivate us to choose forgiveness?
