SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What does it mean to you that God reshapes us rather than discarding us and starting over with someone new?
2. Why do you think God often prepares us through unglamorous, repetitive, and difficult periods to shape and fashion us?
3. In verse 6, God says, "Just like the clay in the potter's hand, so are you in My hand, O house of Israel." This word was originally spoken to a nation, not just individuals. How might this passage apply to us corporately — as a church, a community, or a country — and not only personally?
