## At Home Study Guide – Heaven

### For the week of September 25, 2022

Heaven – do we have an accurate understanding of our eternal home? We hope this series will help you comprehend the glorious truths of the Bible more fully, so that you will grow in joy as you think about heaven. Day 4: Reflect on this sermon today. How does it give you hope and encouragement because of what God has in store for us in the future (Rev. 21:3)?
