Life Group Guide

For the week of May 28, 2023

“The church in the world is called to overcome (Revelation 2-3), that she might be the bride of Christ in glory in the new heaven and new earth (Revelation 21-22)” (James Hamilton). In these seven letters at the beginning of Revelation, John challenges and encourages us, the church, to live faithfully in anticipation of the final victory that we will have through Jesus.

1. Who is Jesus, and who is He for us, according to Rev. 3:7-8a (Look at Rev. 1:5a, 1:18; 6:10; Isaiah 22:22; Matt. 16:19)?
2. What trials are you enduring? How does it help you to know that he knows it all?
3. Notice how many times the word “keep” or “kept” is used in this passage and in the book (2:26; 3:3, 8, 10; 12:17; 14:12). How is he keeping you as you hold fast to His Word and keep it faithfully?
4. Throughout the Bible, especially in Isaiah and Revelation, God speaks of giving us a name. Read these passages, along with Rev. 3:12, and rejoice in the name he has given you as a follower of Jesus (Isaiah 62:2, 65:15, 56:5; Rev. 2:17, 22:3-4, 14:1-4).
