For the week of August 3, 2025

Hebrews 11, often called the “Hall of Faith,” introduces to us, a list of individuals who trusted God despite uncertainty, trials, and challenges. Throughout this series we will focus on a different Faith Walker, examining their story, struggles, and triumphs. Through their unique life stories and God encounters, we pray all of us are spurred on to evaluate and deepen our own faith journey and walk confidently in God’s promises.

1. The illustration of the cloud of witnesses, along with the imagery that follows, gives us a picture of an athletic contest with spectators watching. In what ways are those people discussed in Hebrews 11 helpful to you as you run your race?
2. What can you learn from thinking of the Christian life as a race, specifically as a marathon that you must run?
3. Fix your eyes on Jesus! Jesus is not only the founder, the forerunner and example, he is also the perfecter of our faith. Jesus enables us to do what other examples cannot. How is Jesus enabling you to endure? In what ways are you fixing your eyes on Jesus this week?

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
