1. For further study, read Psalm 90. What do you see of the contrast between	God's
rest in creation and our lack of rest from the fall in verses 1-6?	

2. Jeremy Pierre says that Psalm 90 is a weary Moses reckoning with God about the restlessness of life in the wilderness of the Exodus. How does God sometimes withhold rest from us to work out trust in him (verses 7-11)?

3. Psalm 90:12-17 shows that the Lord compassionately gives us rest in part in this world, more fully later. Like Hebrews 4:9-11, how can we experience partial rest through God in this world as we anticipate the full rest God promises?
