2. What does Jesus mean when he answers the disciple's question in this way (John 9:1-3)?
3. Take some time to read through John 9 and see how the man grows in his understanding of who Jesus is. Describe what you see in the faith of the man born blind.
4. What is Jesus saying to the Pharisees (9:39-41)? In what ways do you need Jesus to open your eyes to see Jesus better?
