3. Chapter 3 mirrors the previous Old Testament event. Which event? Why is God leading these Israelites through a similar crossing of water?

4. As you read through chapter 4, what was the purpose of the 12 memorial stones? What does God want you to remember about his work in the past so that we hope in God (Psalm 78:4, 7)?
