Scripture: 2 Samuel 11–12 and Psalm 51

3. Hidden Sin Cannot Stay Hidden – 2 Sam. 12:1–14
4. Repentance Seeks a Clean Heart – Psalm 51:1–12
5. God Restores the Broken – Psalm 51:13–19
