2. In God's family, no one is an ONLY CHILD.



# Ephesians 5:1-2

The "agape" love of God – it's the kind of behavior that "WILLS the BEST" for someone else.

# Here are a few examples of the Biblical "one anothers":

- Accept one another (Ro 15:7)
- Don't boastfully challenge or envy one another (Ga 5:26)
- Gently, patiently tolerate one another (Ep 4:2)
- Bear with and forgive one another (Co 3:13)
- Don't complain against one another (Jas 4:11, 5:9)
- Confess sins to one another (Jas 5:16)
- Be devoted to one another in love (Ro 12:10)
- Regard one another as more important than yourselves (Php 2:3)
- Serve one another (Ga 5:13)
- Clothe yourselves in humility toward one another (1 Pe 5:5)
- Bear one another's burdens (Ga 6:2)
- Encourage and build up one another (1 Th 5:11)
- Pray for one another (Jas 5:16)

# 3. God's family grows stronger the more we're CONNECTED and COMMITTED to Him and one another.

1 Thessalonians 4:9-10

### COMMUNITY:

people who live in the High Desert & have no connection or awareness of HDC

#### **NEXT STEPS:**

- respond to the Gospel
- · begin attending HDC worship services

## **CROWD:**

people who live in the High Desert and have a loose connection to and awareness of HDC

#### **NEXT STEPS:**

- respond to the Gospel or begin to pursue spiritual growth
- get connected through consistent attendance
- · get baptized

# **CONGREGATION:**

people who live in the High Desert & attend HDC worship services at least 1-2 times a month and are nominally involved beyond that **NEXT STEPS:** 

- · attend Rooted and become part of a Growth Group
- get baptized
- become a member of HDC
- get connected to HDC through more consistent attendance
- · discover your spiritual gifts
- · make financial partnership a consistent rhythm



## **COMMITTED:**

people who live in the High Desert & attend HDC worship services at least 2 times a month and are serving and giving on occasion **NEXT STEPS:** 

- attend weekend worship services more consistently
- · begin consistently giving financially to HDC
- begin serving consistently according to your spiritual gifts
- attend Rooted and become a part of a Growth Group
- take advantage of spiritual growth opportunities like HDC U

## CORE:

people who live in the High Desert & attend HDC worship services at least 3 times a month and are consistently serving, giving, and connected in a small group

#### **NEXT STEPS:**

- consider joining HDC Next
- serve on various ministry teams where the needs are seasonally significant
- · give sacrificially beyond a tithe

What are your <u>NEXT STEPS</u> toward "making yourself at home" in this church family?
