Accountability is what the <u>CHURCH</u> provides for each other.

5 Beliefs or Behaviors That Require Accountability:

- (1) Sexual immorality (1 Corinthians 5:1-8)
- (2) Unwillingness to repent when sinning against a fellow believer (Matthew 18:15-18)
- (3) Unwillingness to forgive a believer who is repentant (Matthew 18:21-35)
- (4) Promoting and teaching false doctrine (2 Timothy 3:1-8)
- (5) Divisiveness (Titus 3:10-11)

Titus 3:10-11, 1 Corinthians 5:1, 1 Corinthians 5:2





1. **GRIEVE** the sin. (James 4:9-10)

- 2. JUDGE the sin. (1 Corinthians 5:3-5)
- Make sure it's God's IDEA.
- Make sure you seek God's WISDOM from others.
- Make sure you are focused on God's PEOPLE.

1 Corinthians 5:9-13, Luke 9:54-56

If we focus on <u>JUDGING</u> the lost, we may hinder them from <u>JOINING</u> the family.

3. REMOVE the sin.





1 Corinthians 5:6

- It's <u>MINIMIZED</u> (just how bad is it really?)
- It's <u>ACCEPTED</u> (it's my little vice)
- It's <u>CELEBRATED</u> (God wants me to be happy).
