The summer will wrap up with a meaningful service project the week of August 3–7, giving students a chance to give back and grow together.

CCKIDS GIVE BACK

Holly LeMaster, our CCKids Director, recently visited the Ronald McDonald House to deliver the incredible 2,145 toiletry items collected during MAD Camp week! These essentials will go directly to guests staying at the house, offering comfort and care during a difficult time.

Holly also dropped off 3.1 pounds of pop tabs already collected by our kids—these tiny tabs are turned in for money that helps fund the house's daily operations.

Pop tab collection is ongoing! If you'd like to contribute, you can send them with any CCKids participant or drop them off with Holly.

In addition, Holly partnered with Meals on Wheels to help serve another unique need—providing for the pets of seniors who receive meals. The kids assembled 197 dog treat bags and 72 cat treat bags. According to Tammy Hitchcock, the volunteer engagement manager, these pet supply donations are one of the most needed and least provided items from outside supporters.

MAKING A DIFFERENCE THROUGH SUMMER READING

Over seven weeks this summer, tutors gathered weekly at Christ's Church to support the Joshua's Place Summer Reading Program. 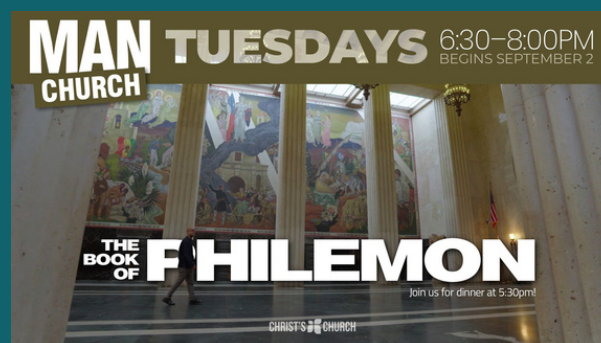
