

God Speaks: Micah 3-5

Read **Micah 3** and discuss the following:

- 1. The Lord denounces the rulers and spiritual leaders of Israel. What reasons does he give? List the charges He brings against them and the consequences of their actions.
- 2. How does Micah's ministry contrast the other prophets of his day (3:8)?
- 3. What does this particular chapter teach us about God and what He desires of and for His people? Explain.

Read Micah 4 and discuss the following:

- 1. Having described the coming destruction of Jerusalem in the previous chapter (3:12), here Micah prophesies of a future day when those fortunes will be reversed. Jerusalem will be rebuilt and exalted. What does the Lord promise to His people?
- 2. How does this oracle describe the nations (4:1-5)? What most stands out to you about their depiction? Explain.
- 3. Why might verse 10 be both discouraging and hopeful for Micah's original audience? Explain.

Read **Micah 5** and discuss the following:

- 1. Micah announces a new and forever ruler to come. How is this ruler described? What makes this specific prophecy so remarkable? Explain.
- 2. What else do we know from Scripture about the little town of Bethlehem? How are each of these additional details significant? Explain.
- 3. How does the coming ruler (Jesus) contrast the rulers of the day described earlier? How does He shepherd differently? Explain.
- 4. How does this passage of Scripture most comfort and/or convict you personally?
