**Numbers 23:19 (NIV)**

*<sup>19</sup> God is not a man, that he should lie, nor a son of man, that he should change his mind. Does he speak and then not act? Does he promise and not fulfill?*

*The Nature of God’s Promises:*

*Trusting in God’s Promises:*

*<sup>5</sup> You will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day, <sup>6</sup> nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday.*

**Psalm 91:11 (NIV)**

*<sup>11</sup> For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways;*

**2<sup>nd</sup> Fear:** *“This virus will be devastating and cataclysmic!”*

Promise: The fate of humanity rests firmly in the hands of \_\_\_\_\_.

**Colossians 1:16-17 (NIV)**

*<sup>16</sup> For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him. <sup>17</sup> He is before all things, and in him all things hold together.*

3<sup>rd</sup> Fear: *“I’m going to run out of food and supplies!”*

Promise: God will always \_\_\_\_\_ for you and your family.

**Psalm 34:9 (NIV)**

*<sup>9</sup> Fear the LORD, you his saints, for those who fear him lack nothing.*

**Matthew 6:33 (NIV)**

*<sup>33</sup> But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.*

4<sup>th</sup> Fear: *“The economy will crash, and I will lose everything!”*
