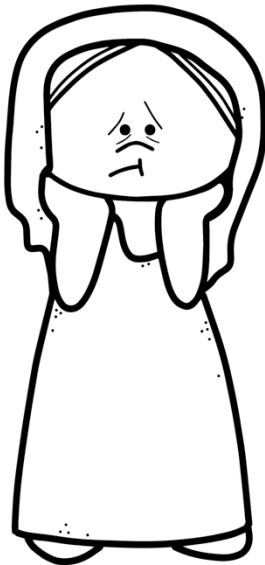
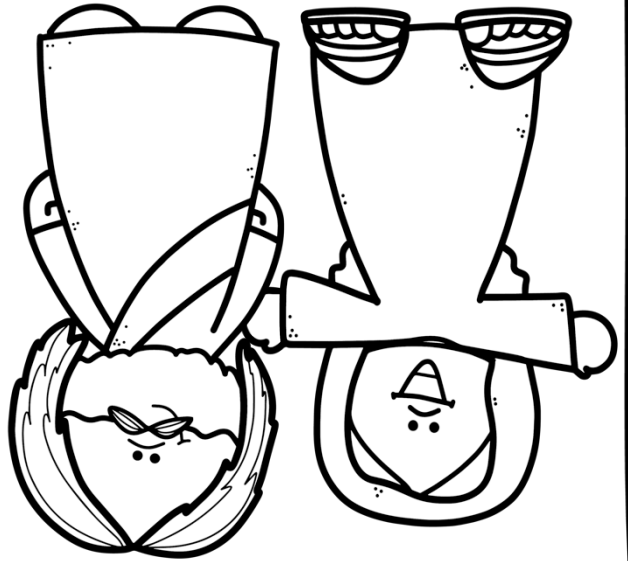


Jesus Heals a Sick Woman

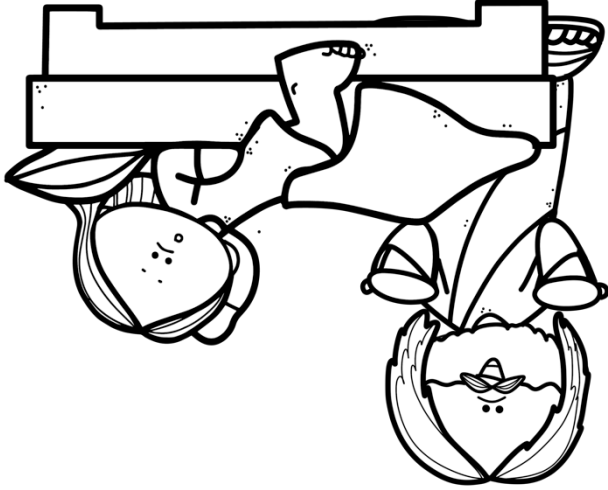


A sick woman believed if she touched Jesus' clothes, she would be healed.

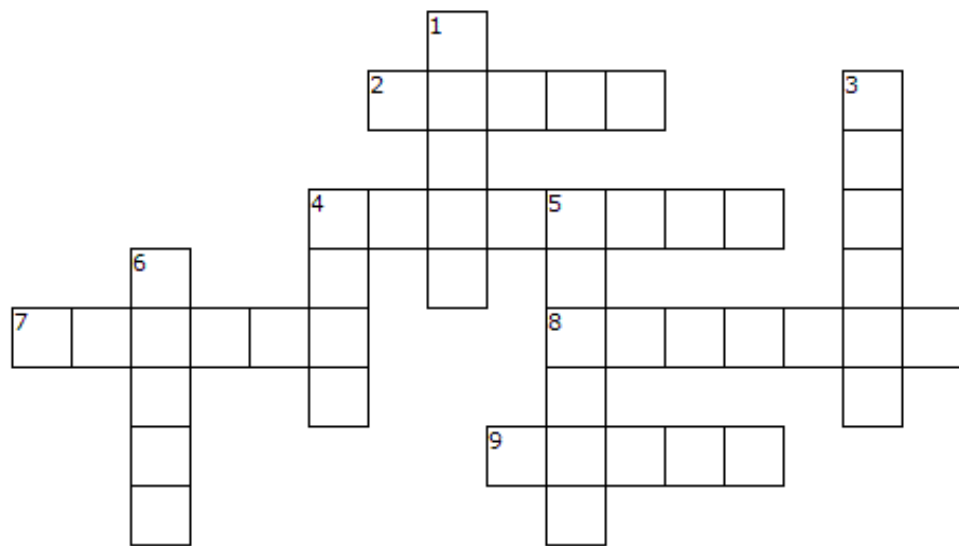

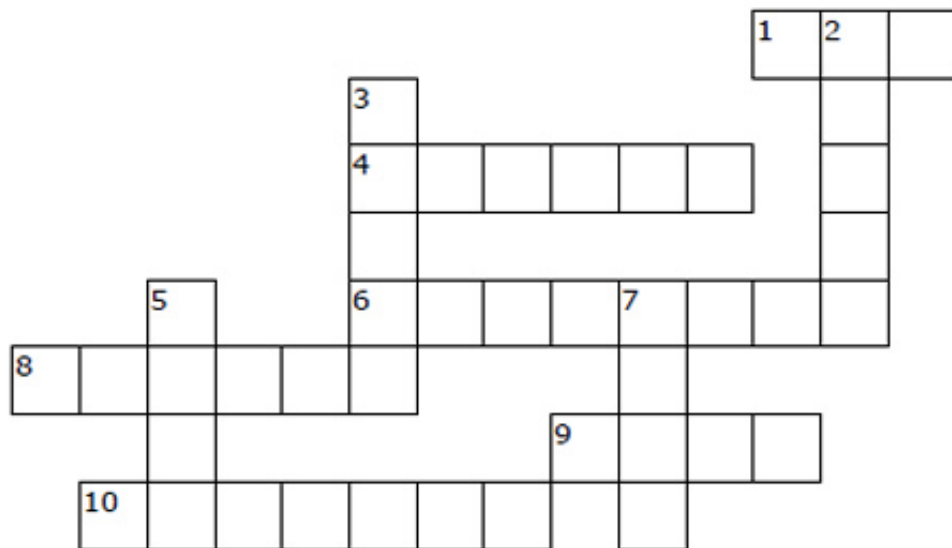
