- Jesus was treated as a criminal-though He never committed any sins or crimes.
- They nailed His hands/wrists, and feet to the cross.
- One criminal next to Him even mocked Him, saying "You've rescued others but You can't rescue Yourself?"
- But the nails, the mocking, the cross, the beating, the crown of thorns- they were all apart of the greatest RESCUE of all time.
- Jesus was fully God and had the power to leave the cross, the mockery, the beatings, all the pain and suffering could have been gone in an instant.

- 4- What did the sign say that the soldiers put above His head? (Our King)
- 5- What did they nail Jesus on? (A big wooden cross)
- 6- Even when they were nailing Him to the cross, what did Jesus pray? (Father forgive them for what they are doing to me)
- 7- When Jesus took our sin, what did God have to do to Jesus (turn His back on Him, punish Him)

SAY: The bible says that Jesus had the power to leave the cross. No one forced Jesus to die- He gave up His life freely, so that He could take the punishment for OUR sins. Jesus loves us so much that He didn't want us to get punished for our sins. So He went to the cross to get our punishment. That's how He rescued us. Let's think about it like this: This is God (hold up GOD PILLOW) This is US (hold up US PILLOW) Before we sinned, we were this close together. (put the pillows next to each other on the ground.) I can get from me to God so easy because we aren't separated. But uh oh, I make some mistakes and I even sin. And now, I am waaaaaaaay over here. (Move pillows apart, the length of the cross) I want to come

back to God, but I'm so far away. Look! (Try to jump close enough but fall short) Guys, we are separated from God and we need to be rescued! So Jesus comes and dies on the cross, (lay down the cross which is the perfect bridge) AND NOW-look!!!! (Walk across the cross back to God)

We were separated from God. We couldn't get to God, so God came to us! Jesus on the cross, made a bridge for us to come back to God. You try it- use the cross to get back to God!! (Help walk all the kids back to God)

Guys isn't it so wonderful that Jesus rescued us? Jesus gave up His life to rescue me!!

WATER And this vase is God and Heaven HOLD UP VASE. When we sin, even the littlest bit- we stop being holy and perfect like God. I lie, I cheat, I have hatred in my heart, I steal, I roll my eyes at my mom when she says to take out the garbage. DROP IN IODINE FROM 'S IN' CUP

Look at what happens to us when we sin- our holiness is compromised. We're not clean and pure and holy, are we? And if I poured this filthy cup of water into God, in Heaven- what would happen? (Try to redirect them if their answers get off track)

SAY: God knew that we needed to rescued and clean from our sin. The last few weeks we have learned that Jesus was always obedient to God, and never sinned. And We learned that Jesus makes us clean. Look at perfect and holy Jesus. HOLD

UP JESUS CUP Perfect and pure like God. And since HE HAD never sinned-He took all our sin, and gave us HIS perfection. DROP IN BLEACH FROM 'JESUS' CUP

He completely washes us clean and takes all of our sin on Him. Jesus gave up His life to rescue us!
