#2 "Rocky Soil": Those who fall away due to	
John 15:18–19 (NIV84) ¹⁸ "If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated me first. ¹⁹ If you belonged to the world, it would love you as its own. As it is, you do not belong to the world, but I have chosen you out of the world. That is why the world hates you.	
#3 "Thorny Soil": Those who fall away due to	
1 Timothy 6:10 (NIV84) ¹⁰ For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.
