- 1. What changes do you see in Judah based on his words and actions in this chapter? What can explain these changes?
- 2. How does Paul describe our condition in Ephesians 2:1-3? What evidence of this condition have you observed in the world?
- 3. What does God do to save fallen people like us (Eph 2:4-10)? What character traits of God explain His actions?
- 4. Why is boasting prohibited for those saved by Jesus (v9)? Instead of boasting, what are we supposed to do in response to God's grace (v10)?
- 5. Read Ephesians 1:11-12. How do you think this connects to God's work described in 2:1-10? How is God's providence at work in salvation?
- 6. How have you seen God's providence at work in your experience of coming to faith in Jesus?
