I. Is hell for real? (v. 19-23a)

- A. The <u>reality</u> of hell.
 - 1. <u>Jesus</u> believed in hell. (Luke 12:5)
 - 2. Logic demands, there is a hell.
 - 3. The Bible teaches very plainly there is a hell.
 - 4. <u>Church history</u> proves there is a hell.
- B. The <u>reason</u> for hell. Hell exists for God to deal righteously:
 - 1. With Satan. (Matthew 25:41)
 - 2. With <u>unbelievers</u>. (II Thessalonians 1:8-9)
 - Hell is full of good, religious people.

II. What is hell like? (v. 23b-28)

- A. Hell is a place of unspeakable <u>suffering</u>.
 - 1. People in hell are in great pain. (v. 23-24)
 - 2. People in hell can see into heaven. (v. 23)
 - 3. People in hell know each other. (v. 23)
 - 4. People in hell possess memory. (v. 25-27)
- 5. People in hell will <u>weep and gnash</u> their teeth. (Matthew 8:12; 13:42; 13:50; 22:13; 24:51; 25:30; Luke 13:28)

- B. Hell is a place of unsatisfied <u>cravings</u>. (v. 24a, 27)
- C. Hell is a place of unquenchable <u>fire</u>. (v. 24b)
- D. Hell is a place of unending <u>separation</u>.
 - 1. People in hell are concerned for others. (v. 27-28)
 - 2. People in hell <u>cannot</u> communicate with the living on earth. (v. 26a)
 - 3. People in hell have no hope of release. (v. 26b)
 - 4. People in hell can't hide from God. (Psalm 139:8)
- E. Hell is a place that lasts forever. (v. 26; Matt. 25:46)

III. How does someone avoid hell? (v. 29-31)

- A. Listen to the <u>Bible</u>. (v. 29)
- B. Accept the gospel. (v. 30-31)

"Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures."

I Corinthians 15:3-4

- Getting into heaven is as simple as ABC:
 - 1. Admit that I need God because I have sinned. (Romans 3:23; 5:8; 6:23)
 - 2. Believe that Jesus died, buried, and rose from the dead.
 - 3. Confess your sins & call on the name of the Lord. (John 17:3; Romans 10:9-13)
- Hell: Don't go there yourself but "go there" (talk about it) so others Don't Go There. (Philemon 1:6)
- Hell is not a place God sends people He's mad at—it's a place people go when they reject the gospel. (I John 5:13)

"This is the way to have eternal life. By knowing the only true God and Jesus Christ the one He sent to earth." John 17:3
