We prefer CIT's to be 15 years or older. If applicant is 16 years or older, a 'Criminal Record & Vulnerable Sector Verification' is required.

Responsibilities

- Responsible to Camp Director.
- To attend Pre-Camp Staff Training.
- To assist their counsellor with cabin and camp program.
- To assist their counsellor in creating an atmosphere of unity and acceptance.
- To be involved with and encourage the participation of the campers in all aspects of daily schedule.

Additional Information

Cell Phones are only to be used for camp business, and can only be used personally before the campers are awake or after the campers are in bed. Modest dress must be worn and encouraged as an example for the campers. Romantic relationships with campers are forbidden. Romantic relationships with other staff are not encouraged and must not become an impediment with the operation of the camp.
