April 2024 **Pastor's Letter**

Grace and peace to you from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ; grace that provides divine assistance for daily living and peace to comfort us through all circumstances of life! The Apostle Paul started most of his New Testament letters to Christians with this blessing to encourage them, and I want you to receive and experience that blessing and encouragement as well. The Good News is that you can experience the fullness of God's blessings of grace and peace. That's why David explained that God guides us along the right paths for his name's sake.

But sometimes, it's hard to make up your mind on what is and isn't God's will when you're seeking God's guidance. When you can't make up your mind, you stagger in life. In fact, the Bible says in James 1, when you remain indecisive, you are double-minded, and become unstable in everything you do.

But God says there is an antidote to indecision. Psalm 23:3 says, "He guides me along the right paths for his name's sake." You'll be able to handle the stress of decision-making when you let God guide you.

You may be thinking, "But I've tried that!" You asked God to guide you, but then you became more confused than you were before, and you still couldn't figure it out. Now you wonder, "Why is knowing God's will so difficult?" Is God playing games with you?

Of course not! God does want to guide you! In fact, the Lord wants you to know His will more than you want to know it. The problem is... when you're trying to find God's will, you often look for the wrong thing.

Think of it this way, maybe you're looking for a feeling. You want to be swept off your feet by some emotion so you can say, "That's how I know what God's will is!" Or you may be looking for a method to discovering God's will, like following a recipe. Some people are looking for Christian magic approach to discovering God's will and you're looking for God to give you a big sign, like something explained with skywriting.

But all these ways will be frustrating and cause you to miss God's will. God's will is not a feeling, or a recipe, or something mystical for you to learn. God does not want you frustrated or confused, and he does not want you to stress over making a decision.

The next time you're making a big decision, rest in the truth that the answer to discovering God's will is so simple, it is profound! The answer... "let the Lord guide you along the right paths." That's it! Simple!






