#### June 2023 Pastor's Letter

Grace and peace to you from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ; grace that provides divine assistance for daily living and peace to comfort us through all circumstances of life through the power of the Holy Spirit! Those words reflect the opening blessing of Paul the Apostle as he opens his letters in the Bible to believers; and it is blessing that I want for you!


On May 17, the Waterford Heritage Committee held an event where they recognized the spiritual legacy of Waterford. I was asked to give a presentation at the Waterford Library on the history of the Community Church. If you are not familiar with the Waterford Heritage Committee, it is an extension of the Explore Waterford program, which is the local branch of the National Main Street Community Program, authorized by the State of Wisconsin to promote local businesses and preserve the historic nature of our community. As I researched material from our 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary, God showed me a few things. Here are just a sample of the legacy of the Community Church!

- 1873 The legacy of the Community Church was born out of a revival that Holy Spirit brought to Waterford in the Winter of 1869-1870. The revival was very powerful and even the hardest lives were converted. According to our records, the German Episcopal and English Episcopal Churches were started shortly afterwards. The buildings were soon completed and dedicated around 1873.
- 1923 The ministry of the churches transitioned when the German and English Episcopal Churches merged, and the "United German and English Episcopal Church" was dedicated. Important point, the demographics of the Waterford Community had significantly changed, the residents no longer spoke primarily German, but transitioned to English!
- 1939 As ministry grew, the legacy developed further when the name of the church was legally changed to "The Methodist Church" it is not clearly identified, but empirical data implies that the name "Community" was added to the church's name. However, more research is needed. The church had 141 active members at the time.
- 1945 Property of the old German Church, the empty triangle shaped vacant lot across from the High School, was deeded to the Village of Waterford with the provision that it be made into a memorial or park site and it is not to be used for commercial use. The church was also to erect a suitable marker designating the location of the German Episcopal Church. Unfortunately, no marker has ever been erected, this promise is one that the Community Church needs to fulfill at some point!
- 1956 Additional land was purchased north of the church 25 feet from Potokars for \$300 and 70 feet from Stalbaums for \$100 to create a parking lot and educational wing/Fellowship Hall was built onto the north side of the church.
- 1959 The new addition was consecrated October 3.
- 1968 A new parsonage was built and the Methodist Episcopal Church and Evangelical United Brethren Church merged to create the United Methodist Church.
- 1970 God brought Pastor Garcia to the Community United Methodist Church. Pastor Garcia brought the Community Church back to its biblical foundation of making Disciples of Jesus Christ and evangelism.

- 1984 Pastor Garcia went to the Lord and God brought Pastor Cheever. Both pastors greatly developed the Kingdom of God and the Lord's legacy of biblical teaching, Spirit led ministry and evangelism at the Community Church
- 1992 Fund drive started for new church.
- ? God showed Steve Dirks the property through realtor Al Mehring, Steve showed property to Pastor Cheever.
- 1994 April 10, Groundbreaking for the current Community Church on Jefferson Street.
- 1995 De-consecration of the Main Street Church and the new church was consecrated. The old church building was purchased by B. and C. Lindau who repurposed it as an antiques and collectibles business with small shops in the basement.
- 2014-2016 Congregation went through a difficult, but necessary pruning and the congregation went from 250 down to 80 in worship.
- 2016 The Community Church started to intentionally rebuild its ministry and attendance started to grow.
- 2017 The congregation approved a new logo for the Community United Methodist Church.
- 2018 Servant Community (A young adult church and ministry) and its sister ministry The Epworth League, joined into cooperative Ministry with the Community United Methodist Church and the Community Regional Shared Ministry was created.
- 2019 150 Anniversary Celebration. Regular Sunday attendance was growing to over 200 and the St. James United Methodist Church joined the Community Regional Shared Ministry.
- 2020 COVID-19 pandemic started in the US, and public ministry activities (including worship was halted by the Wisconsin State government). Fortunately, public worship resumed with restrictions in July. Worship attendance dropped significantly.
- 2021 Ministry continued to rebuild during the COVID-19 Pandemic. The Union Grove United Methodist Church joined the Community Regional Shared Ministry.
- 2022 The Global Methodist Church was founded, all churches in the Community Regional Shared Ministry decided to investigate Disaffiliating from the United Methodist Church over issues of interpretation of Scripture and theological reasons.
- 2023 The Community United Methodist Church and the Union Grove United Methodist Church voted to Disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church, later voting to Affiliate with the Global Methodist Church.

As a person reviews the history of the Community Church, one may notice that large events for the Community Church came every 10 years or so for the first 140 years of the church's history. But starting in 2014, major events started manifesting in the life of the Community Church. A trifecta of ministry altering events that ranged from a church pruning to a global pandemic, to disaffiliating from the United Methodist Church and Affiliating with the Global Methodist Church. The exciting part of the story is that the Community Church has come through each event in a healthy manner.

I believe that the Lord has brought the Community Church to this point for a reason, and together we will continue moving toward the destiny the Lord has for our congregation as we continue worshipping the Lord, seeking His will, and being obedient to His Word as we make Disciples of Jesus Christ. May we continue in God's grace, peace and comfort as we participate in the divine assistance Holy Spirit provides for daily living!



Ephesians is a powerful letter, written by the Apostle Paul where he answers questions about faith and the Church in remarkable ways. 
# FOOD PANTRY


