Journey to the Holy Land

November 4 - Departure

Your journey begins when you depart the USA on your overnight international flight.

November 5 - Arrival

Welcome to the Holy Land! You will be met at the airport by our representative and transferred to your hotel in the Netanya area for dinner and a good night's rest.

November 6 - From Sea to Sea

Arrive at the coastal port city **Caesarea Maritima**, where Cornelius became the first gentile convert and where Paul was imprisoned before being sent to Rome for trial. Head east to the **Mount of Precipice** overlooking **Nazareth**, the boyhood home of Jesus. Stand on **Mt. Carmel**, where Elijah defeated the prophets of ba'al. Follow the ancient caravan route to **Tel Megiddo**, an exciting archaeological dig with its layers of twenty different cities built on top of each other, overlooking the Plains of Armageddon. Visit the Franciscan Wedding church in Cana, where the first miracle of Christ is remembered. Couples wanting to have their vows renewed may do so here.

November 7 - Jesus in the Galilee

Start your day at the recent excavations of Magdala, the hometown of Mary Magdalene. Enter the 2,000 year old remains of Capernaum and stand in what is left of the synagogue in which our Lord ministered. Enjoy a St. Peter's Fish lunch (included). Stop at Tabgha, where the feeding of the 5,000 is remembered at the Church of the Loaves and Fish. Gather at the Jordan River for a time of spiritual blessing when you can remember or renew your baptism. Finish the day with a sunset sailing across the Sea of Galilee to share in a special time of fellowship & worship on the water.

November 8 – Jerusalem

Start your morning at **Gideon's Spring**, site of the choosing of Gideon's army of 300 men to do battle with the Midianites. Visit **Genesis Land** and have lunch in Abraham's Tent. Next, stop in **Jericho** to view the ruins of the city conquered by Joshua. In the distance you can also see the traditional site of the Temptation of Jesus. In modern Jerusalem, visit the Israel Museum to see a 1st Century Model of Jerusalem and the **Shrine of the Book Exhibit** where the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed. Stand on top of the **Mount of**

Olives. It was from here that Jesus ascended to heaven 40 days after the resurrection. Walk the **Palm Sunday Path**, recalling shouts of "Hosanna" during the Triumphal Entry, making your way to the **Garden of Gethsemane**, where Jesus prayed among the olive trees the night He was betrayed with a kiss.

November 9 - Jerusalem

See the **Temple Mount**, once the site of the Temple of Solomon. Pray alongside the Jewish faithful at the **Western Wall** and visit the **Southern Wall Excavations** including the Teaching Steps. On **Mt. Zion** enter the **Upper Room**, the traditional location of the Last Supper. Visit Nebi Samuel (**Samuel's Tomb**), thought to be the burial place of the prophet Samuel.

November 10 - Southern Ruins and Waters

Visit **Qumran**, site of the Dead Sea Scroll discovery, to learn about the mysterious community of Essenes who once lived on the shores of the **Dead Sea**. Stop at the shores of the Dead Sea, the lowest spot on earth, for an opportunity to take a quick dip in the mineral-laden waters. On your way back to Jerusalem, pass through the **Judean Wilderness** paralleling the ancient Roman road to view the deep gorge of **Wadi Qelt**, which may be the **"Valley of the Shadow."** From here, you can see St. George's Monastery across the gorge.

November 11 - Jerusalem

Walk through the **Old City** and enjoy the preserved, ancient culture found in the narrow streets as well as the modernized **Cardo** in the Jewish Quarter. See the **Wohl Archaeological Museum** and the **Burnt House**, where the remains of Jewish families' homes from the time of the Roman destruction of Jerusalem in 70 AD can be seen. View the **Pool of Bethesda** where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle. Walk a portion of the **Via Dolorosa** (the way of suffering) as you recall the walk of Jesus to the cross. Take time to reflect on the agony of the cross at **Gordon's Calvary** and the miraculous reality of the resurrection at the **Garden Tomb**. Prepare for your late night flight.

November 12 - Return

Return home with a transformed faith and memories to last a lifetime!


