RE-EMERGING...

AS COVID-19 VACCINATIONS CONTINUE TO ROLL OUT AND THE VIRUS SEEMS TO BE SPREADING MORE SLOWLY, WE ALL FEEL A RENEWED SENSE OF HOPE THESE DAYS.

We're moving forward cautiously.

I want to express appreciation from the entire congregation to our Re-emerge Team – Lowndes Pope (chair), Margaret Hays, Carolyn Hall, Darren Foy, Joe Stone, Bill Metzger, Nancy Probst, Lesli Wood, Jamie McCutcheon, James Grubb, and myself. This group has worked tirelessly over the last year to help us remain active in ministry while staying safe.

At the beginning of the pandemic they developed protocols, which they continue to monitor and adjust as appropriate. As the situation remains very dynamic, this group continues to meet on a monthly basis.

Please remember that although we are steadily re-emerging, we will not fully re-emerge for some time. Since it's baseball season, here's my baseball analogy ... We're coming around third base, and we don't want to get thrown out on the way to home plate. In the days ahead some of you are going to feel like we're not opening up fast enough – please be patient with us. On the other hand, some of you will feel like we're going too fast – please continue to take advantage of our online opportunities. We will be listening to the guidance of scientists and public health officials and doing our best to adapt their recommendations to our situation at Shandon. At this point there are enough unanswered questions to keep us moving forward cautiously but hopefully.

Here are a few things to look for in the days ahead ...

- On Palm Sunday we will restart our 11:00 a.m. sanctuary service.
- On Easter Sunday we will offer the following services:
 - 7:00 a.m. Sunrise Service
 - 8:45 a.m. Sanctuary Service with overflow in the gym
 - 11:00 a.m. Sanctuary Service
 - 11:05 LifeLine Service
- We will continue all three worship services through the summer. By not combining the 11:00 a.m. sanctuary and LifeLine services as we usually do in the summer, we will be able to welcome more worshippers and spread them out more safely.
- Beginning on Palm Sunday we'll raise the attendance caps to 125 in the sanctuary 150 in the gym.
- We'll continue working toward a full return to Sunday School, which for many of us is the hub of Sunday mornings. However, this is a complex project which will have to move forward incrementally. As a first step, we plan to begin offering some alternative onsite Sunday School opportunities soon after Easter.
- Because of extra traffic from the 11:00 a.m. sanctuary service and construction in the Adger Road driveway, we are suspending drive-through Communion.
- Masks and social distance are still required inside all Shandon buildings.
