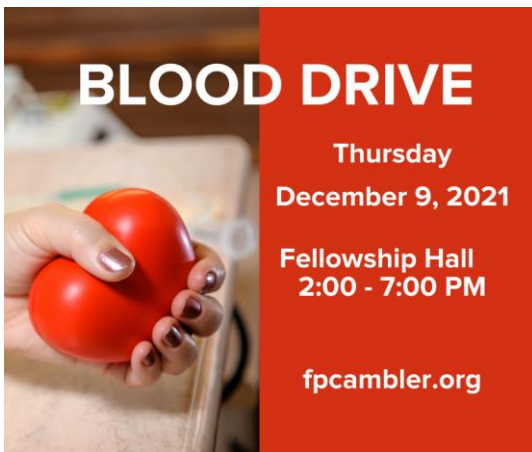


BAKE SALE – DECEMBER 5
