Dear Hope Family,

As we step into the second month of the year, we also approach the season of Lent, which begins this year on **Wednesday, February 18**, with Ash Wednesday, and culminates on **Thursday, April 2**, leading into **Good Friday on April 3** and the Easter weekend. For me, Lent has always been a special time to walk deeply with God. It is not simply about giving something up—it is about transformation and genuine change of heart. Each year, I intentionally set aside quiet moments for daily prayer and meditation. During one past Lenten season, I remember praying through a difficult decision I had wrestled with for months. One morning, I experienced a profound sense of peace and clarity that reminded me God is always present, even in moments of uncertainty.

Lent is a season of reflection, spiritual growth, repentance, and self-examination. While prayer and repentance are part of our ongoing faith journey, Lent offers a focused opportunity to walk alongside Jesus in his humility, service, and suffering. Above everything else, Jesus came not to be served, but to serve. His death clearly demonstrates the suffering of a servant who endured pain and sacrifice for the beloved people of God.

This season invites us to ask ourselves how we are dedicating our lives to serving others—not only during Lent, but always as people called to be faithful witnesses of Jesus Christ. As Jesus reminded his disciples on the day he washed their feet: "**So, if I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. For I have set you an example, that you also should do as I have done to you.**" John 13:14–15. As we journey through Lent together, I encourage you to notice the small yet meaningful ways God is speaking to you. Consider sharing those moments with someone else—they may be the encouragement they need. May this season draw us closer to Christ and shape us more fully into servants of his love.

Our Mission Focus for February is **Lord's Acre**. If you haven't already, please sign up on the poster in the Narthex. This is a project with decades-old roots from our old congregations - but has been modified – so you needn't be a "farmer" or even know anything about farming to get involved. If you sign up as a "renter", you make a once a year donation of \$70 to Hope UMC. Once all the Farmers pledges and renter donations are collected in early March, an annual meeting with all those involved get together after worship and decide how to divide and who should receive the collective funds. This is our 2025 "Crop"! Recipients change from year to year depending on ideas and suggestions from the group. A recent example is Camp Scholarships we make available to any Hope kids that want to go to summer camp. Please sign up and bring your ideas on how to use our 2025 crop in early March.

Coming up end of February (Ash Wednesday), our Mission Focus will be **BUCC-y Bags** with our Lenten Offering! We'll be filling "Lenten Jars" with coins collected for that right up to Easter Sunday on April 5. Please see the Lenten Coin Calendars on the bulletin boards by the restrooms.



Then in April our focus is **Seeds of Hope** – a second year for the gardens. Please take some time to fill out the enclosed questionnaire and return! Your input is very valuable in planning this year's season!



There are no limits to mission giving at Hope. **Anytime** during the year, you can bring in items for the food shelf, Bundle Up items, bags for Weaving Mats or even items for the Emma Norton Home. Plus, **Anytime** during the year you are moved to give to any of our mission projects, just label the memo line of your check and place in the offering plate. Did you know? Last fall, Hope raised funds to help **Midwest Mission Distribution Center** (MMDC) purchase and pay for the their building in Jefferson, Iowa. We also sent bicycles, sewing machines, wheelchairs and walkers there to be distributed along with the donated building funds. Thanks to all who contributed! LAKE CRYSTAL AREA REC CENTER—Sunday, February 15th from 4-10PM



Realm-Online Giving Info



Since starting our new software called **Realm** in late 2024 and having learned quite a bit over the past 12 months, we are ready to have our Hope UMC members and friends start using this software as well as the staff!

Everyone in our church gets a unique profile. Your profile contains everything you want people in our church to know about you. Your profile also enables

you to track your giving, update your contact information, change family details, set notification preferences, or replace that outdated family photo (which goes along with the new pictorial directory pictures being taken in January).

By keeping your information current, you are helping our staff, group leaders, and our church community. Privacy settings will be gone over in more detail once you create your profile.

Your Profile includes:

- Contact Information* (e.g. name, address, email, phone)
- Photo
- Family Members
- Personal Information (e.g. marital status, birthday**, etc.)

*You can decide later what data you want to hide online by setting your privacy preferences.

**Feel free to enter your full birthday. The year and your age will not be displayed on your church directory profile.



Review your giving history or make new donations online or on your mobile phone. Simply sign in to look over your year-to-date giving, print a contribution statement, or make a new one-time or recurring donation. It's always available and kept secure in an easy-to-use online environment.

Prior to meeting with me or creating your profile on your own, you will need to have a [valid email address on file with the church office](#)

(Carolyn). Once I have an email address for you, I can send an emailed invitation to join our Realm world. Also, you can start thinking of a password for your profile. I will work with those that need assistance to get their profile set up correctly.

Current online contributors, I will help you migrate your current online giving to the new system.

Password Requirements

- Between 8 and 15 characters.
- Includes no part of your email address.
- Includes no repeating characters such as **aaa**
- Includes none of the following: **< > & ^ \ ; % ` ' /**
- Also no keyboard sequences such as **asdfgh**
- Includes no numeric or alphabetical sequences such as **12345** or **abcde**
