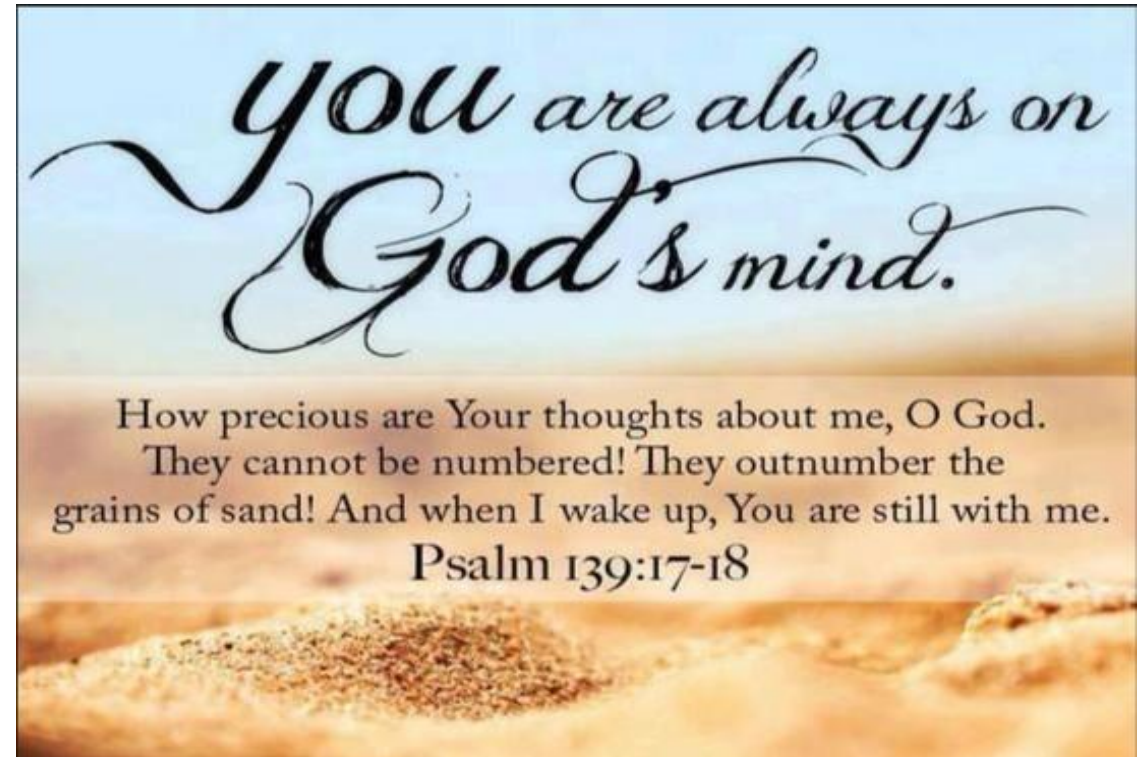
ANNOUNCEMENTS
