25 "But Abraham said, 'Son, remember that in your lifetime you received your good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things; but now he is comforted and you are tormented.

26 'And besides all this, between us and you there is a great gulf fixed, so that those who want to pass from here to you cannot, nor can those from there pass to us.'

27 "Then he said, 'I beg you therefore, father, that you would send him to my father's house, 28 'for I have five brothers, that he may testify to them, lest they also come to this place of torment.'

29 "Abraham said to him, 'They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them.' 30 "And he said, 'No, father Abraham; but if one goes to them from the dead, they will repent.'

31 "But he said to him, 'If they do not hear Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded though one rise from the dead."

Another Thought

Rich man's name is not given.

Beggar is honored with a name, Lazarus = One whom God helps.

One is esteemed by Jesus and the other is despised and rejected

The Great Equalizer Comes to Both

Death

vs22

"So it was that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels to Abraham's bosom. The rich man also died and was buried.

Lazarus died

"and was carried by the angels"

Rich Man Died

"The rich man also died and was buried."

The emphasis is upon his burial.

"carried to Abraham's Bosom"

(vs 25) "now he is comforted"

Abraham's Bosom / Paradise

Ephesians 4:8-10

8 Therefore He says: "When He ascended on high, He led captivity captive, and gave gifts to men."
9 (Now this, "He ascended" --what does it mean but that He also first descended into the lower parts of the earth? 10 He who descended is also the One who ascended far above all the heavens, that He might fill all things.)

Hades - The Underworld

"in torments" (vs 23, 24, 25) Severe pain, severe suffering



Jesus, Mark 9:43-48

43 "If your hand causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter into life maimed, rather than having two hands, to go to hell, into the fire that shall never be quenched-- 44 "where 'their worm does not die, and the fire is not quenched.'

45 "And if your foot causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter life lame, rather than having two feet, to be cast into hell, into the fire that shall never be quenched-- 46 "where 'their worm does not die, and the fire is not quenched.'

47 "And if your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out. It is better for you to enter the kingdom of God with one eye, rather than having two eyes, to be cast into hell fire-- 48 "where 'their worm does not die, and the fire is not quenched.'

Revelation 20:11-15

11 Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away. And there was found no place for them. 12 And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books.

Revelation 20:11-15

13 The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works. 14 Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

15 And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.
