

Message #4: A Different Kind of Giant

6 Now it had happened as they were coming home, when David was returning from the slaughter of the Philistine, that the women had come out of all the cities of Israel, singing and dancing, to meet King Saul, with tambourines, with joy, and with musical instruments.

7 So the women sang as they danced, and said: "Saul has slain his thousands, and David his ten thousands."

8 Then Saul was very angry, and the saying displeased him; and he said, "They have ascribed to David ten thousands, and to me they have ascribed only thousands. Now what more can he have but the kingdom?"

9 So Saul eyed David from that day forward.

10 And it happened on the next day that the distressing spirit from God came upon Saul, and he prophesied inside the house. So David played music with his hand, as at other times; but there was a spear in Saul's hand.

- 11 And Saul cast the spear, for he said, "I will pin David to the wall!" But David escaped his presence twice.
 - 12 Now Saul was afraid of David, because the LORD was with him, but had departed from Saul.

- 13 Therefore Saul removed him from his presence, and made him his captain over a thousand; and he went out and came in before the people.
- 14 And David behaved wisely in all his ways, and the LORD was with him.

- 15 Therefore, when Saul saw that he behaved very wisely, he was afraid of him.
- 16 But all Israel and Judah loved David, because he went out and came in before them.

(NKJV)

- David has just defeated Goliath.
- David and Jonathan have forged a strong friendship.

- David is instantly a rockstar.
 - He becomes the most loved person in all Israel.



-All seems well in paradise, until it isn't.

King Saul is triggered.

(vs 8)

Then Saul was very angry, and the saying displeased him; and he said, "They



have ascribed to David ten thousands, and to me they have ascribed only thousands. Now what more can he have but the kingdom?" • <u>Very angry</u> = become hot, burn with anger



• <u>Displeased</u> = implies making a loud noise, violent reaction

Threatened by David Jealous Rage

JAMES 3:14-16

- 14 But if you have bitter envy and self-seeking in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth.
- 15 This wisdom does not descend from above, but is earthly, sensual, demonic.
- 16 For where envy and self-seeking exist, confusion and every evil thing are there.

(vs 9) So Saul eyed David from that day forward.



(vs 10a)

And it happened on the next day that the distressing spirit from God came upon Saul, and he prophesied inside the house.

 Prophesied = used negatively here, like speaking out of his mind in a fit

Remember, Saul started pretty good.



1 Samuel 10:6-12

"changed him into a new man"

"and he prophesied"

- **▶18:10** "distressing spirit from the LORD"
- ➤ 16:14 "the Spirit of the LORD departed from Saul, and a distressing spirit from the LORD troubled him"

Distressing = evil, bad
Troubled = tormented

(vs 9)

So Saul eyed David from that day forward.

Deuteronomy 32:5
They have corrupted themselves; They are not His children, because of their blemish: a perverse and crooked generation.



Wicked Crooked

How can we be free? Prophecy about Jesus

Isaiah 42:16

I will bring the blind by a way they did not know; I will lead them in paths they have not known. I will make darkness light before them, and crooked places straight. These things I will do for them, and not forsake them.

TWO WORDS

Sin Rebellion

- Saul was disobedient & rebellious
- He refused to repent.
- "the Spirit of the LORD departed from him"

TWO WORDS

Sin Rebellion

- Saul's life shows us the awful consequences of an unrepentant heart.
- Don't play games with God. You will lose!

THOUGHT

1 Corinthians 5:5

deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.

MTERESTING REMEDY

(vs 10b)

So David played music with his hand, as at other times; but there was a spear in Saul's hand.

SAUL - WICKEDNESS

- 4 Assassination attempts in this chapter
 - -2 spear chunks "I will pin David to the wall"
 - **—2 Evil Plots involving the Philistines**
 - —Sending David to battle hoping the Philistines would kill him

SAUL - WICKEDNESS

Deceptive lie (with daughter, Merab)

- Plot to ruin David's life (Michal)
 - -"she may be a snare to him"
 - **–Dowry: 100 >> 200 Philistines...**

Servant Heart

David...Continued to serve inspite of Saul's threats (the music, the battles)

Heavenly Wisdom

(vs 14) And David behaved wisely in all his ways, and the LORD was with him.

Faithfulness, Consistency

Did NOT allow Saul's madness to shut him down, stayed faithful

(vs 16) But all Israel & Judah loved David, because he went out & came in before them.

Stay Humble

(vs 23) "Does it seem to you a light thing to be a king's son-in-law, seeing I am a poor and lightly esteemed man?"

"God gives grace (empowerment) to the humble"

Servant Heart
Heavenly Wisdom
Faithfulness, Consistency
Stay Humble

THE BLESSING

(vs 30) Then the princes of the Philistines went out to war. And so it was, whenever they went out, that David behaved more wisely than all the servants of Saul, so that his name became highly esteemed.
