Episcopal Church Partnership — A Message from Rev. Davis-Shoemaker

Last November, Bishop Ruth Woodliff Stanley appointed Rev. Courtney Davis-Shoemaker as the Priest-In-Charge of St. Peter's Episcopal Church (previously Church of the Good Shepherd) at 1393 Miles Drive. The building was returned to the Episcopal Church in 2022 after the schism in the Episcopal Diocese in 2012 and it became clear that renovation was needed on the building before a community could regularly worship there. In December, Rev. Courtney met with Pastor Ryan, Deacon Ashlyn, and Deacon Katie to explore the possibility of offering an Episcopal worship service at Redeemer one Sunday a month at 4pm while construction is underway.

Before coming to Charleston with her family in 2017, Rev. Courtney served as a chaplain at Elon University serving the group LEAF (Lutherans, Episcopalian, and Friends). Rev. Courtney writes, "Having served with Lutherans in the past, I immediately looked around to who I could reach out to as partners in ministry and Pastor Lyles and Redeemer welcomed us into the space." After meeting with Redeemer's Council in January and getting approval, the Episcopal group worshiped for the first time at Redeemer on Sunday, January 26. Each month a small group worships together and then goes out to dinner.

As the construction continues at St. Peter's, Rev. Courtney and the parish administrator are now working out of Redeemer's choir room during the summer months. Rev. Courtney writes, "We are enormously grateful for the hospitality we've been shown by the staff and community of Redeemer as we work to reestablish an Episcopal Church in West Ashley. Your generous and welcoming spirit has encouraged us during a time that can feel challenging and overwhelming. Jesus reminds us to extend hospitality to our neighbors and the Lutheran Church of the Redeemer is doing just that. Thank you for your Christ-like presence in the life of our faith community."
